

Chiastic Structure




Chiasmus, Chiasm

- a literary device in which a sequence of ideas is presented and then repeated in reverse order. The result is a “mirror” effect as the ideas are “reflected” back in a passage. Each idea is connected to its “reflection” by a repeated word, often in a related form.
- The term chiasm comes from the Greek letter chi, which looks like our letter X. Chiastic pattern is also called “ring structure.”



ABBA - Simple Chiasmi

- “When the going gets tough, the tough get going”
- “By failing to prepare, you are preparing to fail.”
- “The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.”
- Whoever exalts himself will be humbled,
and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.



ABCCBA – Matt. 6:24

A No one can serve two masters.

B Either he will hate the one

C and love the other,

C'or he will be devoted to the one

B' and despise the other.

A' You cannot serve both God and Money.

ABCDDCBA – Joshua 1:5-9

A As I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will never leave you nor forsake you (5b)

B Be strong and courageous ... be strong and very courageous (6,7a)

C Be careful to obey all the law ... that you may be successful (7b)

D Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth (8a)


