

“Holy Ones”



Kedoshim – Lev. 19:1-2

וידבר יהוה אל-משה לאמר:

דבר אל-כל-עדת בני-ישראל ואמרת אלהם
קדשים תהיו כי קדוש אני יהוה אלהיכם:

- 1 And יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying,
- 2 “Speak to all the congregation of the children of Yisra’ël, and say to them, ‘Be **holy**, for I יהוה your Elohim am **holy**.’

Leviticus 19:2

- “Speak to all the congregation of the sons of Israel and say to them, ‘You shall be **holy**, for I the LORD your God am **holy**. (NASB)
- English: **holy**
- Spanish: **santo**, sagrado
- Hebrew: **Kadosh**
 - Strong’s: “sacred, **HOLY**, sanctified, set apart”
- But what is “**HOLY**?”

- SUN god worship: Babylon




Meaning of Halos

- Meaning: “Blessed by the SUN.”



But Today?

- The sun is still in churches.



“For I Am *Holy*?”



- Lev. 11:44 - ‘For I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be **holy**, for I am **holy**. And you shall not make yourselves unclean... (NASB)
- Lev. 11:45 - ‘For I am the LORD who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be **holy**, for I am **holy**.’”
- I Peter 1:16 - because it is written, “YOU SHALL BE **HOLY**, FOR I AM **HOLY**.”
- Lev. 20:26 - ‘Thus you are to be **holy** to Me, for I the LORD am **holy**; and I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine.
- Lev. 21: 8 - ...for I the LORD, who sanctifies you, am **holy**.

“Kadosh”

- Hebrew: **Kadosh**
 - Strong’s: “sacred, **HOLY**, sanctified, **set apart**”
 - **Separate**, separated, distinct
- “Speak to all the congregation of the children of Yisra’el, and say to them, ‘**Be set-apart**, for I, יהוה your Elohim, am **set-apart**. (ISR Scriptures)
- “Set-apart?” “Be **separate** for I am **separate**.”
- If **separate**, *from what?*

IPV: “Be *Separate...*”

- Lev. 11:44 ‘For I am יהוה your Elohim, and you shall **separate yourselves**. And you shall be **separated**, for I am **separate**.
- 45 ‘For I am יהוה who is bringing you up **out of the land of Egypt**, to be your Elohim. And you shall be **separated**, for I am **separate**.
- Lev. 20:26 ‘And you shall be **separated** to Me, for I יהוה am **separate**, and have **separated** you **from the nations** to be **Mine**.
- Lev. 21: 8 - For I, יהוה, **separating you**, am **separate**.
- I Peter 1:16 - because it has been written, “Be **separate**, for I am **separate**.”

HOW to be **Separate** – Lev. 19

- Honor parents
- Keep the Sabbath
- No idols, other gods
- Leave gleanings
- Don't steal, lie, defraud
- Pay laborers promptly
- Do not take advantage of deaf, blind
- Judge fairly
- Don't take vengeance
- Don't hold grudges
- LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF

HOW to be **Separate** – Lev. 19

- Don't cross-breed livestock (mix)
- Don't mix seeds in a field
- Don't mix materials in clothing
- Don't eat fruit from a young tree
- Don't eat blood
- No divination, or fortune-telling
- Don't round your hair or beard (for the dead)
- Don't gash your flesh, or get tattoos for the dead
- Don't prostitute your daughters
- Honor Yah's sanctuary
- Do not turn to ghosts or inquire of spirits

HOW to be **Separate** – Lev. 19, 20

- Rise before the white-headed
- Do not wrong strangers, love them as self
- Don't falsify measures, cheat in trading
- Don't sacrifice children to other gods
- Don't turn to mediums
- Don't insult parents
- Don't lay with family members
- Men don't lay with other men
- Don't lay with animals
- **DON'T DO AS THE NATIONS AROUND YOU DO!**

Yeshua - Matthew 5:48

- “Therefore you are to be **perfect**, as your heavenly Father is **perfect**. (NASB)
- “Therefore, be **perfect**, as your Father in the heavens is **perfect**. (ISR)
- Nowhere in Torah, does YVHV say “I am **perfect**.”
- Yeshua is quoting Lev. 19:2! “Be **separate**...”
- So was Peter! “Be **separate** for I am **separate**.”
- Does this fit the *context* of Matthew 5?...

HOW to be **Separate** – Matt. 5



- Blessed are YOU when persecuted...
- YOU are the salt of the earth...
- YOU are the light of the world...
- All of the Torah will be done...
- KEEP even the least commandments...
- You've heard it said, but I say to YOU...
- But I say to YOU...
- Turn the other cheek
- Give to those who ask...
- Love your enemies...

Matthew 5:45-48

- 45 so that YOU become sons of your Father in the heavens. (**separate!**) Because He makes His sun rise on the wicked AND on the good, and sends rain on the righteous AND on the unrighteous.
- 46 “For if you love those loving you, what reward have you? Are the tax collectors not doing the same too?”
- 47 “And if you greet your brothers only, what do YOU do more than others? Are the tax collectors not doing so too?”
- 48 “Therefore, be **perfect separate**, as your Father in the heavens is **perfect separate**.
- **BE DIFFERENT** THAN THE WORLD!

Parable of the Sower

Matthew 13:1-8, Mark 4:1-9, and Luke 8:4-8




The Word Among Thorns



Mark 4:18-19, "And these are the ones sown among thorns; *they are* the ones that hear the word, and **the cares of this world**, the deceitfulness of **riches**, and the **desires of other things** entering in, choke the word, and it becomes **unfruitful.**" (MIXED, not **separate**)

Good Ground



Luke 8:15, "But the ones *that* fell on the good ground are those who, in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, **KEEP it**, and bring forth fruit with patience."

We **keep it** by being **separate** from the world.

Fruitfulness



- “Some 30, some 60 and some 100-fold”


Fruitfulness

- 10 = maturity, completeness




Fruitfulness

- 30 = maturity w/
mature disciples
(tripled)




Fruitfulness

- 60 fold = maturity w/ disciples that have mature disciples!




Fruitfulness

- 100 fold = maturity w/ disciples that are discipling disciplers!



John 15



- I am the vine, you are the branches. He who **abides** in me, and I in him, **bears much fruit**; for without me you can do nothing...
- By this my Father is glorified, that you **bear much fruit**; so you will be **my disciples**...
- You did not choose me, but **I chose you**, and **appointed you** that you should **go and bear fruit**, and that your fruit should remain: that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give you.”

Conclusions

- Our “Holy” translations are misleading. We have to study the Torah, and we have to study the Hebrew.
- We are commanded to be **separated** from this world, as our Heavenly Father is **separate**, and *He* is our Elohim.
- We stay separated from the world by **keeping His Word**.
- We become **mature** and **fruitful** by keeping His Word, staying separate, not mixed with the ways of the world around us.
- **HE CHOSE US**, and *appointed* us, to **bear much fruit**.
