Matthew (Mateo) 4:18-19

And Yeshua, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. Then he said to them, "Follow me, **and**

I will make you fishers of men."

Matthew (Mateo) 28:19-20

"Go therefore and make disciples **of all the nations**, mikvahing them in the (name) authority of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, [even] to the end of the age."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:10-11

"All of you stand today before YHVH your Elohim:
your leaders and your tribes and your elders and
your officers, all the men of Israel,
your little ones and your wives--also the stranger
who [is] in your camp, from the **one who cuts your**
wood to the **one who draws your water.**"

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:12-13

“That you may enter into covenant with YHVH your Elohim, and into His oath, which YHVH your Elohim makes with you today,

that **He may establish** you today as a people for **Himself**, and [that] He may be Elohim to you, just as He has spoken to you, and just as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:14-15

"I make this covenant and this oath, not with you
alone,

but with [him] who stands here with us today
before YHVH our Elohim, as well as with [him] who
[is] not here with us today."

(Open covenant? Time/people?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:2

“Blessed [is] the man [who] does this, and the son of man [who] lays hold on it; who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and keeps his hand from doing any evil.”

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:3

Do not let the son of the foreigner who **has joined himself to YHVH** speak, saying, "YHVH has utterly separated me from His people"; Nor let the eunuch say, "Here I am, a dry tree."

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:4

For thus says YHVH: "To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, and choose what pleases Me, and **hold fast My covenant...**"

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:6

“Also the sons of the foreigner **who join themselves to YHVH**, to serve Him, and to love the name (authority) of YHVH, to be His servants--
Everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath,
and holds fast My covenant...”

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:7-8

“Even them I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [will be] accepted on My altar (?); **for My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.”**

YHVH Elohim, who gathers the outcasts of Israel (Net), says, **“Yet I will gather to him [Others] besides those who are gathered to him.”**

Words to Examine

- Lay hold on- Chazak- to tie fast, to bind, bond strongly, be strong, fig. repair, fortify
- Joined oneself- Lavah- to twine, unite, remain, cleave
- Hold fast- Chazak- **Covenant**
- Join themselves- Lavah- **YHVH**

Numbers (Numeros) 15:37-38

Again YHVH spoke to Moses, saying,
"Speak to the children of Israel: **Tell them to make tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a blue thread in the tassels of the corners.**"

Numbers (Numeros) 15:39-40

“And you shall have the tassel, that you may look upon it and remember all the commandments of YHVH and do them, and that you [may] not follow the harlotry to which your own heart and your own eyes are inclined, and that you may remember and do all My commandments, and be holy for your Elohim.” (10 men from all nations Lay hold of Tzit tzit) (Join themselves)

Zechariah (Zacarias) 8:22-23

Yes, many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek YHVH of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before YHVH. "Thus says YHVH of hosts: 'In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve (hem, tzit tzit) of a Jewish man, saying, "Let us go with you (follow), for we have heard [that] Elohim [is] with you." ' "

(Emanuel)

(Heard Elohim is with you?)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:6

Therefore be careful to observe [them]; for this [is] your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes, and say, “Surely this great nation [is] a wise and understanding people.”
(Who is seen & heard?)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:7-8

For what great nation [is there] that has Elohim [so] near to it, as YHVH our Elohim [is] to us, for whatever [reason] we may call upon Him? And what great nation [is there] that has [such] statutes and righteous judgments as are in all this law which I set before you this day? (Hold fast and Join to?)

John (Juan) 17:17-19

“Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

As You sent me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.

And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.”

John (Juan) 17:20-22

“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word (others);

that they all may be one, as You, Father, [are] in me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent me. And the glory which You gave me I have given them, **that they may be one just as We are one:”**

John (Juan) 17:23

“I in them, and You in me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that **the world** may know that You have sent me, and have loved them as You have loved me.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 30:1-2

"Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call [them] to mind among all the nations where YHVH your Elohim drives you, and you return to YHVH your Elohim and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 30:3-4

“That YHVH your Elohim will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again **from all the nations** where YHVH your Elohim has scattered you. (make them disciple/net?) If [any] of you are driven out to the farthest [parts] under heaven, **from there YHVH your Elohim will gather you, and from there He will bring you.”**

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 30:19-20

"I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, [that] I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that **you may love YHVH your Elohim, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cleave to Him,** for He [is] your life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which YHVH swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and **Jacob,** to give them." (Grafted vine-tree)

Matthew (Mateo) 24:12-14

"And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.

But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come."
