# Matthew (Mateo) 21:33

Hear another parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country.

# Matthew (Mateo) 21:34-35

Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, **that they might receive its fruit.**

And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another.

## Matthew (Mateo) 21:36-37

Again he sent other servants, more than the first,  
and they did likewise to them.

Then last of all he sent his son to them, saying,  
“They will respect my son.”

## Matthew (Mateo) 21:38-39

But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, “This is the heir. Come, let us **kill him and seize his inheritance.**”

So they took him and cast [him] out of the vineyard and killed [him].

# Matthew (Mateo) 21:40-41

Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?

They said to him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease [his] vineyard to other vinedressers **who will render to him the fruits in their seasons.**"

(Has this happened before?)

# Matthew (Mateo) 21:34-35

Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, **that they might receive its fruit.**

And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another.



**WHY?**

## Genesis 4:1-2

Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from YHVH."

Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

# Genesis 4:3-5

And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to YHVH. **Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat.** And YHVH respected Abel and his offering, but He did not respect (turn away) Cain and his offering. And **Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.**

(Why was Cain angry? Defensive? Blame?)

# Genesis 4:6-7

So YHVH said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?

**If you do well, will you not be accepted?** And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire [is] for you, but you should rule over it."

(Choose you this day- blessings/curses-go out door!!? Cut off from people- unclean=put out)

# Genesis 4:8

Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, **when they were in the field**, that **Cain (possess-acquire) rose up against Abel (breath) his brother and killed him.**

## Genesis 4:10-11

"So, now you [are] cursed from the earth, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand.

When you till the ground, it shall no longer yield its strength to you. A fugitive and a vagabond you shall be on the earth." (Like Satan)

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:15

"But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of YHVH your Elohim, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, **that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you...**"

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:18

"Cursed [shall be] the **fruit** of your body and the **produce (fruit)** of your land, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks."

(Same as Adam & Eve- Cain & Abel?)

**Why would vinedressers not give fruit in its season?**

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:21

“They have provoked Me to jealousy by [what] is not elohim; they have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. But I will provoke them to jealousy by [those who are] not a nation; I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.”

# Romans (Romanos) 11:11

Did (part of) Elohim's people stumble and fall beyond recovery? Of course not! They were disobedient, so Elohim made salvation available to the Gentiles (Nations). **But he wanted his own people to become jealous and claim it for themselves.**

(Claim what?)

# Romans (Romanos) 11:12

Now if the Gentiles (Nations) were enriched  
because the people of Israel turned down  
Elohim's offer of salvation (Repent), **think how**  
**much greater a blessing the world will share when**  
**they finally accept it.**

# Romans (Romanos) 11:14-15

For I want somehow to make the people of Israel jealous of what you Nations (Gentiles) have (Favor Torah-blessings, closeness to Father), **so I might save some of them.** For since their rejection meant that Elohim offered salvation to the rest of the world, their acceptance will be even more wonderful. **It will be life for those who were dead!** (Example?)

# Genesis 37:3-4

Now Israel loved (favor-lover) Joseph more than all his children, because he [was] the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of [many] colors.

But when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, **they hated him and could not speak peaceably to him.**

# Genesis 37:12-13

Then his brothers went to feed their father's flock  
in Shechem.

And Israel said to Joseph, "Are not your brothers feeding [the flock] in Shechem? **Come, I will send you to them.**" So he said to him, "Here I am."

# Genesis 37:14

Then he said to him, "Please go and see if it is well with your brothers and well with the flocks, and bring back word to me." So he sent him out of the Valley of Hebron, and he went to Shechem.  
(Go check on my Shepherds and the flock.)

## Genesis 37:15-16

Now a certain man found him, and there he was, wandering in the field. And the man asked him, saying, "What are you seeking?"

So he said, "I am seeking my brothers. Please tell me where they are feeding [their flocks]."

(YHVH called to Adam and said, "Where are you?")

# Genesis 37:17

And the man said, "They have departed from here, for I heard them say, 'Let us go to Dothan.' "  
**So Joseph went after his brothers and found them  
in Dothan.**

# Genesis 37:18

Now when they saw him afar off, even before he came near them, **they conspired against him to kill him.**

(Given to another nation- Salvation to the nations)

(What kind of Fruit?)

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:32-33

For their vine [is] of the vine of Sodom and of the fields of Gomorrah; **their grapes [are] grapes of gall, their clusters [are] bitter.** Their wine [is] the poison of serpents, and the cruel venom of cobras.

(Shema & believe whose words? You can be like elohim)

Why did the vinedressers not give their fruit in its season?

## Matthew (Mateo) 21:28-30

"But what do you think?" A man had two sons, and he came to the first and said, 'Son, go, work today in my vineyard.' He answered and said, 'I will not,'  
but afterward he regretted it and went.

Then he came to the second and said likewise. And he answered and said, 'I [go], sir,' but he did not go."

## Matthew (Mateo) 21:31

"Which of the two did the will of [his] Father?"

They said to him, "The first." Yeshua said to them,

"Assuredly, I say to you **that tax collectors  
and harlots enter the kingdom of Elohim  
before you.**"

How do we  
react to  
conviction?

## Acts (Hechos) 2:37-38

Now when they heard [this], they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men [and] brethren, what shall we do?"

Then Peter said to them, **"Repent, and let every one of you be mikvahed** in the authority (name) of Messiah Yeshua for the remission of sins; and you **shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."**

(Take not your Holy Presence from me...)

## Acts (Hechos) 7:52-53

"Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the **Just One**, of whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers, who have received **the law** by the direction of angels and have not kept [it]."

# Acts (Hechos) 7:54,57-58

"When they heard these things **they were cut to the heart**, and they gnashed at him with **[their] teeth (example)**. Then they cried out with a loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him with one accord; and **they cast [him] out of the city and stoned [him]**. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul. (blame-punishment)

# John (Juan) 16:1-3

"These things I have spoken to you, that you should not be made to stumble.

They will put you out of the synagogues; yes, **the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers Elohim service.**

And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me."

# Matthew (Mateo) 23:34-35

"Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes: [some] of them you will kill and crucify, and [some] of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city, **that on you may come all the righteous blood shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel** to the blood of Zechariah, son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar."

(Blood of the saints- White washed tombs)

# Matthew (Mateo) 23:37-38

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her!  
How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under [her] wings, **but you were not willing!**  
See! **Your house** is left to you desolate."

# Jeremiah (Jeremias) 12:10-11

**Many rulers have destroyed My vineyard, they have trodden My portion underfoot; they have made My pleasant portion a desolate wilderness. They have made it desolate; desolate, it mourns to Me; the whole land is made desolate, **because no one takes [it] to heart.****

(Take what to heart? Desolate =Curses=Rebuke)

# Matthew (Mateo) 23:39

For I say to you, you shall see me no more till you say, “Blessed [is] He who comes in the authority (name) of YHVH!””



# Matthew (Mateo) 21:38-39

But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, “This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance (authority-power).”

So they took him and cast [him] out of the vineyard and killed [him].

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:1-2

"Now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the judgments which I teach you to observe, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which YHVH Elohim of your fathers is giving you.

You shall **not add to the word** which I command you, **nor take from it**, that you may keep the commandments of YHVH your Elohim which I command you."

## Isaiah (Isaias) 45:22-23

"Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I [am] Elohim, and [there is] no other. I have sworn by Myself; the word has gone out of My mouth [in] righteousness, and shall not return (void), that to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall take an oath."
