## Genesis 6:3

And YHVH said, "My Spirit shall not strive (judge, plead, contend) with man forever, for he [is] indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

## Genesis 32:24-25

Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.

Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.

# Genesis 32:26,28

And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!" And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed (endured)."

# Genesis 1:27-28

So Elohim created man in His [own] image; in the image of Elohim He created him; male and female He created them. Then Elohim blessed them, and Elohim said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

(You may not eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil for the day you eat, you shall surely die.)

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 30:19

"I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, [that] **I have set before you** life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live."

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 30:17-18

"But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and worship other elohim and serve them, **I announce to you today that you shall surely perish;** you shall not prolong [your] days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to go in and possess."

(Blessings & Curses- Predestined-Plan)

## Genesis 15:15-16

"Now as for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you shall be buried at a good old age.

But in the fourth generation they shall return here, **for the iniquity of the Amorites [is] not yet complete."**

## Amos 3:2-3

You only have I known of all the families of the earth: **therefore I will punish you for all your iniquities.**

Can two walk together, **except they be agreed?**

## Amos 3:6

If a trumpet is blown in a city, will not the people be afraid? If there is calamity (evil) in a city, **will not YHVH have done [it]?**

(Cursed be the ground for your sake)

## Isaiah (Isaias) 45:5-6

I [am] YHVH, and [there is] no other; [There is] no Elohim besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, that they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting that [there is] none besides Me. I [am] YHVH, and [there is] no other.

## Isaiah (Isaias) 45:7

I form the light and create darkness, I make peace  
and create calamity (evil); I, YHVH, do all these  
[things].

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:39

"Now see that I, [even] I, [am] He, And [there is] no Elohim besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal; nor [is there any] who can deliver from My hand."

# Genesis 25:22

But **the children struggled together within her;**  
and she said, "If [all is] well, why [am I like] this?"

So she went to inquire of YHVH.

(2 nations in your womb- Older will serve the  
younger)

# Malachi (Malaquias) 1:2-3

"I have loved you," says YHVH. "Yet you say, 'In what way have You loved us?' [Was] not Esau Jacob's brother?" Says YHVH. **"Yet Jacob I have loved; but Esau I have hated, and laid waste his mountains and his heritage for the jackals of the wilderness."**

## Romans (Romanos) 9:6-8

But it is not that the word of Elohim has taken no effect. For they [are] not all Israel who [are] of Israel, nor [are they] all children because they are the seed of Abraham; but, **"In Isaac your seed shall be called."** That is, those who [are] the children of the flesh, these [are] not the children of Elohim; **but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.**

# Romans (Romanos) 9:9-11

For this [is] the word of promise: "At this time I will come and Sarah shall have a son."

And not only [this], but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, [even] by our father Isaac (for [the children] not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of Elohim according to election might stand, not of works but of Him who calls)...

# Romans (Romanos) 9:10,12-13

And not only [this], but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, [even] by our father Isaac  
it was said to her, "The older shall serve the younger."

As it is written, "Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated."

# Romans (Romanos) 9:14

What shall we say then? [Is there] unrighteousness with Elohim? Elohim forbid.

# Romans (Romanos) 9:15-16

He says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion (Ex. 33:19)."

So then [it is] not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, **but of Elohim who shows mercy.**

# Romans (Romanos) 9:17-18

For the Scripture says to the Pharaoh, "For this very purpose I have raised you up, that I may show My power in you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth."

Therefore He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens.

## Romans (Romanos) 9:19

You will say to me then, "Why does He still find fault? For who has resisted His will?"

# Romans (Romanos) 9:20-21

But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against Elohim? Will the thing formed say to him who formed [it], "**Why have you made me like this?**"

Does not the potter have power over the clay,  
from the same lump to make one vessel for honor  
and another for dishonor?

(Pharaoh?-YHVH harden his heart? )

## Exodus (Exodo) 7:1,3

So YHVH said to Moses: "See, I have made you [as] Elohim to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet.

And **I will harden Pharaoh's heart**, and multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt."

# Exodus (Exodo) 7:4-5

"But Pharaoh will not heed you, so that I may lay My hand on Egypt and bring My armies [and] My people, the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments. **And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] YHVH, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the children of Israel from among them."**

(Mixed Multitude, Not all Israel is Israel)

# Exodus (Exodo) 7:20

And Moses and Aaron did so, just as YHVH commanded. So he lifted up the rod and struck the waters that [were] in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh and in the sight of his servants. **And all the waters that [were] in the river were turned to blood.**

## Exodus (Exodo) 7:22-23

Then the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments; and Pharaoh's heart grew hard, and he did not heed them, as YHVH had said.  
And Pharaoh turned and went into his house.  
Neither was his heart moved by this.

## Exodus (Exodo) 9:16-17

"But indeed for this [purpose] I have raised you up, that I may show My power [in] you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth.

As yet you exalt yourself against My people in that you will not let them go."

# Exodus (Exodo) 9:27-28

And Pharaoh sent and called for Moses and Aaron, and said to them, "I have sinned this time. YHVH [is] righteous, and my people and I [are] wicked. Entreat YHVH, that there may be no [more] mighty thundering and hail, for [it is] enough. **I will let you go, and you shall stay no longer.**"

# Exodus (Exodo) 9:34-35

And when Pharaoh saw that the rain, the hail, and the thunder had ceased, **he sinned yet more; and he hardened his heart, he and his servants.** So the heart of Pharaoh was hard; neither would he let the children of Israel go, as YHVH had spoken by Moses. (Kavad-be heavy, grievous, hard, rich, dull-honor, glorify)

# Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:21-22

"But if a wicked man turns from all his sins which he has committed, keeps all My statutes, and does what is lawful and right, he shall surely live; he shall not die.

**None of the transgressions which he has committed shall be remembered against him; because of the righteousness which he has done, he shall live."**

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:23

"Do I have any pleasure at all that the wicked should die?" says YHVH Elohim, "[and] not that he should turn from his ways and live?"

# Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:24

"But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked [man] does, shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die."

# Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:29-30

"Yet the house of Israel says, 'The way of YHVH is not fair.' O house of Israel, is it not **My ways which are fair, and your ways which are not fair?**

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways," says YHVH Elohim.

**"Repent, and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin."**

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:32

"For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies," says YHVH Elohim. **"Therefore turn and live!"**

## YHVH's Will (Plan)

- YHVH needs to get Joseph to Egypt
- Growing up around Laban
- Jacob's special treatment
- Joseph- concern for right-love of Father, Boastfulness, Dreams
- Judah- "Let's sell Joseph," Marries Canaanite, Sons, Tamar, "I will bear the blame."

# Genesis 45:7-8

"And Elohim sent me before you to preserve a posterity for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.

**So now [it was] not you [who] sent me here, but Elohim;** and He has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt."

(We wrestle with Elohim and His will)

# Predestination vs. Free Will

- Are we predestined? His Will.
- Do we have free will? Our Will.
- YHVH knows the heart, knows our thoughts before we say them (prayer)
- 2 nations divided from the womb- blessings & curses
- I have wrestled with Elohim and flesh & have endured

## Ephesians (Efesios) 2:8-9

For by grace you have been saved **through faith**,  
and that not of yourselves; [it is] the gift of God,  
not of works, lest anyone should boast.

## Matthew (Mateo) 6:9-10

"In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name (Authority). Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as [it is] in heaven."

# Romans (Romanos) 8:28-30

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to [His] purpose. For whom He foreknew, He also predestined [to be] conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified (Hard-Strong).

**Teach me to do Your will,** for You [are] my Elohim; Your Spirit [is] good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.
