Genesis 32:(3)4-36:43

Then Jacob **sent** messengers before him to Esau his brother in the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

And YHVH said, "My Spirit shall not strive (judge, plead, contend) with man forever, for he [is] indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

Genesis 32:3-4

Then Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother in the land of Seir, the country of Edom. And he commanded them, saying, "Speak thus to my lord Esau, 'Thus your servant Jacob says: "I have dwelt with Laban and stayed there until now.'""

Genesis 32:5-6

"I have oxen, donkeys, flocks, and male and female servants; and I have sent to tell my lord, that I may find favor in your sight."

Then the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, **"We came to your brother Esau, and he also is coming to meet you, and four hundred men [are] with him."**

Genesis 32:7

So Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed; and he divided the people that [were] with him, and the flocks and herds and camels, into **two companies.**
(Israel divided)

Genesis 32:9-10

Then Jacob said, "O Elohim of my father Abraham and Elohim of my father Isaac, YHVH who said to me, 'Return to your country and to your family, and I will deal well with you': I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies and of all the truth which You have shown Your servant; for I crossed over this Jordan with my staff, and now I have become two companies."

Genesis 32:24-25

Then Jacob was left alone; and a **Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.**

Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.

(Something wrong with his walk?)

Genesis 32:26,28

And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"

And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed."

Genesis 25:22

But **the children struggled together within her;** and she said, "If [all is] well, why [am I like] this?" So she went to inquire of YHVH.

Genesis 25:25-26

And the first came out red. [He was] like a hairy garment all over; so they called his name Esau.

Afterward his brother came out, and

his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so

his name was called Jacob

(supplanter). Isaac [was] sixty years old when she bore them.

(Wrestle, Hold on, Named)

(Born again-Mikvah in Spirit)

Hosea- Repent?

Hosea (Oseas) 12:2-3

YHVH also [brings] a charge against Judah, And will punish Jacob according to his ways; according to his deeds He will recompense him (Judge). He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and in his strength he struggled with Elohim.

Hosea (Oseas) 12:4-5

Yes, he struggled with the Angel and prevailed; he wept, and sought favor from Him. **He found Him [in] Bethel,**

and there He spoke to us--

That is, YHVH Elohim of hosts. YHVH
[is] His memorable name.

(Jacob- Angel that redeemed me-bless
with name)

Hosea (Oseas) 12:6

So you, by [the help of] your Elohim,
return; observe mercy and justice,
and wait on your Elohim continually.

Genesis 32:26

And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"

Joel 2:12-13

"Now, therefore," says YHVH, "Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning."

So rend your heart, and not your garments; **return to YHVH your Elohim**, for He [is] gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; And **He relents from doing harm.**

Joel 2:14

Who knows [if] He will turn and relent,
and leave a blessing behind Him--A
grain offering and a drink offering For
YHVH your Elohim?

Genesis 32:28

And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed."

Psalms (Salmos) 143:10

Teach me to do Your will, for You [are]
my Elohim; Your Spirit [is] good. Lead
me in the land of uprightness.

Isaiah (Isaias) 30:15

For thus says YHVH Elohim, the Holy One of Israel: **"In returning and rest you shall be saved;** in quietness and confidence shall be your strength."
