Genesis 32:24-25

Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.

Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, **He touched the socket of his hip;** and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.

Genesis 32:26,28

And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"

And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed (endured)."

Genesis 32:29-30

Then Jacob asked, saying, "Tell [me] Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why [is] it [that] you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there.

So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: **"For I have seen Elohim face to face, and my life is preserved."**

Genesis 6:3

And YHVH said, "**My Spirit shall not strive with man forever**, for he [is] indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

Luke (Lucas) 20:15-16

"Now at vintage-time he sent a servant to the vinedressers, that they might give him some of the fruit of the vineyard.

But the **vinedressers beat him and sent [him] away empty-handed.** Again he sent another servant; and **they beat him also, treated [him] shamefully,** and sent [him] away empty-handed.

And **again he sent a third; and they wounded him also and cast [him] out."**

(Wrestling gets serious)

Genesis 4:3-5

And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to YHVH. **Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat.** And YHVH respected Abel and his offering, but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.

Genesis 4:7-8

"If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire [is] for you, but you should rule over it."

Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, **that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.**

Genesis 37:3-4

Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he [was] the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of [many] colors.

But when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him and could not speak peaceably to him.

(Favored? After Joseph told his father about his brothers, Favor = Obedience)

Exodus (Exodo) 8:22-23

"And in that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, in which My people dwell, that no swarms [of flies] shall be there, **in order that you may know that I [am] YHVH in the midst of the land.**

I will make a difference between My people and your people. Tomorrow this sign shall be."

Genesis 39:4

So **Joseph found favor in his sight**, and served him. Then he made him overseer of his house, and all [that] he had he put under his authority.
(Made in His image- Made Jealous?)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:21

They have provoked Me to jealousy by what] is not elohim (Satan-demons); they have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. **But I will provoke them to jealousy by [those who are] not a nation;** I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.

Romans (Romanos) 11:11,13-14

I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! **But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation [has come-offered] to the Gentiles.** For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry, **if by any means I may provoke to jealousy [those who are] my flesh and save some of them. (example)**

1 Kings (Reyes) 18:21

And Elijah came to all the people, and said, "How long will you falter between two opinions? If YHVH [is] Elohim, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him." But the people answered him not a word.

1 Kings (Reyes) 18:30-31

Then Elijah said to all the people, "Come near to me." So all the people came near to him. **And he repaired the altar of YHVH [that was] broken down.** And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, to whom the word of YHVH had come, saying, "Israel shall be your name."

1 Kings (Reyes) 18:38-39

Then the fire of YHVH fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood and the stones and the dust, and it licked up the water that [was] in the trench. **Now when all the people saw [it], they fell on their faces; and they said, "YHVH, He [is] Elohim! YHVH, He [is] Elohim!"**
(Egypt-set Israel apart)

1 Kings (Reyes) 19:1-2

And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, also how he had executed all the prophets with the sword. Then Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah, saying, "So let the Elohims do [to me], and more also, if I do not make your life as the life of one of them by tomorrow about this time."

1 Kings (Reyes) 19:3-4

And when he saw [that], he arose and ran for his life, and went to Beersheba, which [belongs] to Judah, and left his servant there.

But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree. And he prayed that he might die, and said, "It is enough! Now, YHVH, take my life, for I [am] no better than my fathers!"

Exodus (Exodo) 10:28-29

Then Pharaoh said to him, "Get away from me! Take heed to yourself and see my face no more! **For in the day you see my face you shall die!**"

So Moses said, "You have spoken well. I will never see your face again."

Matthew (Matteo) 21:34-36

"Now when vintage-time drew near (Cain & Abel), he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. And the vinedressers took his **servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another.** Again he sent other servants, more than the first, and they did likewise to them." (Generations-Generational curse)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 7:25-26

"Since the day that your fathers came out of the land of Egypt until this day,

I have even sent to you all My servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending [them]. **Yet they did not obey Me or incline their ear, but stiffened their neck.** They did worse than their fathers."

Hosea (Oseas) 6:5

Therefore I have hewn [them] by the prophets, I have slain them by the words of My mouth (sword); **and your judgments [are like] light [that] goes forth.**

John (Juan) 1:4-5

In him was life, and the life was the
light of men.

And the light shines in the darkness,
and the darkness did not
comprehend it (Overcome it).

Matthew (Matteo) 21:37-38

"Then last of all he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.'

But when the vinedressers saw the son (Joseph & Brothers), they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.'"

(Inheritance? Joseph showed favor- given authority)

Psalm (Salmos) 110:1-2

A Psalm of David. YHVH said to my Adonai,
"Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies
Your footstool."

YHVH shall send the rod of Your strength
out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your
enemies!

(Joseph-Moses, authority of prophets-
WORD)

(Wrestling start? Become enemies-
wrestling to death?)

Genesis 1:26

Then Elohim said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

(Korach-Satan)

Genesis 3:4-5

Then the serpent said to the woman,
"You will not surely die.

For Elohim knows that in the day you
eat of it your eyes will be opened,
and you will be like Elohim, knowing
good and evil."

(Seed planted- What fruit is
produced?)

(What was the seed that was
planted?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 14:12-13

"How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! [How] you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations!

For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of Elohim; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north.'"

Isaiah (Isaias) 14:14

“I will ascend above the heights of
the clouds,

I will be like the Most High.”

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 28:12-13

"Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, 'Thus says YHVH Elohim: "You [were] the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. **You were in Eden, the garden of Elohim**; every precious stone [was] your covering: The sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes Was prepared for you on the day you were created.'""

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 28:2

"Son of man, say to the prince of Tyre, 'Thus says YHVH Elohim:

"Because your heart [is] lifted up,
And you say, '**I [am] an elohim, I sit [in] the seat of elohim, in the midst of the seas,**' Yet you [are] a man, and not an elohim, though you set your heart as the heart of an elohim."'"

John (Juan) 8:39-40

They answered and said to him, "Abraham is our father." Yeshua said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works (bear fruit) of Abraham.

But now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth which I heard from Elohim. Abraham did not do this."

"You do the deeds of your father."

Then they said to him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father--Elohim." Yeshua said to them, "If Elohim were your Father, you would love me, for I proceeded forth and came from Elohim; nor have I come of myself, but He sent me.

Why do you not understand my speech? Because you are not able to

John (Juan) 8:44

"You are of [your] father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own [resources], for he is a liar and the father of it."
(Call them Father, YHVH, Master)

Matthew (Mateo) 23:29-30

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! **Because you build the tombs of the prophets and adorn the monuments of the righteous,** and say, 'If we had lived in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.'"

Matthew (Mateo) 23:31-33

"Therefore you are witnesses against yourselves that you are sons of those who murdered the prophets.

Fill up, then, the measure of your fathers' [guilt].

Serpents, brood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell (grave)?"

Matthew (Mateo) 23:34

"Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes:
[some] of them you will kill and crucify, and [some] of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city."

Matthew (Mateo) 23:35

“That on you may come all the
righteous blood shed on the earth,
from the blood of righteous Abel to
the blood of Zechariah, son of
Berechiah, whom you murdered
between the temple and the altar.”
(Love of many will grow cold.)

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 6:9-10

When He opened the fifth seal, I saw
under the altar the souls of those
who had been slain for the word of
Elohim and for the testimony which
they held. And they cried with a loud
voice, saying, "How long, O YHVH,
holy and true, until You judge and
avenge our blood on those who
dwell on the earth?"

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 6:11

Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer,

until both [the number of] their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they [were], was completed.

Luke (Lucas) 20:15-16

"So they cast him out of the vineyard and killed [him]. Therefore what will the owner of the vineyard do to them?"

He will come and destroy those vinedressers and give the vineyard to others." And when they heard [it] they said, "Certainly not!"

Luke (Lucas) 20:17-18

Then he looked at them and said,
"What then is this that is written:

'The stone which the builders
rejected Has become the chief
cornerstone'?

**Whoever falls on that stone will be
broken; but on whomever it falls, it
will grind him to powder."**

(Pharisees wanted to lay hands on
him-knew he spoke the parable
about them.)

Luke (Lucas) 19:27

“But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay [them] before me.”

(Then Messiah goes off to Jerusalem)

Exodus (Exodo) 14:17-18

"And I indeed will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them. So I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army, his chariots, and his horsemen.

Then the Egyptians shall know that I [am] YHVH, when I have gained honor for Myself over Pharaoh, his chariots, and his horsemen."
