Genesis 6:3

And YHVH said, "My Spirit shall not strive (judge, plead, contend) with man forever, for he [is] indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

Genesis 32:24-25

Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.

Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.

Genesis 32:26,28

And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!" And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed (endured)."

Genesis 48:15-16

And he blessed Joseph, and said: "Elohim, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, the Elohim who has fed (shepherded) me all my life long to this day,

The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; let my name be named upon them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth."

(Elohim = Angel?-Connection?)

Hosea (Oseas) 12:3-4

He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and in his strength he struggled with Elohim. Yes, he struggled with the Angel and prevailed; he wept, and sought favor from Him. He found Him [in] Bethel, and there He spoke to us— (Man or Angel?)

Judges (Jueces) 13:3

And the Angel of YHVH appeared to the woman and said to her, "Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son."

Judges (Jueces) 13:6

So the woman came and told her husband, saying, "A Man of Elohim came to me, and His countenance [was] like the countenance of the Angel of Elohim, very awesome; but I did not ask Him where He [was] from, and He did not tell me His name."

Judges (Jueces) 13:8

Then Manoah prayed to YHVH, and said, "O my Lord, please let the Man of Elohim whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born."

Judges (Jueces) 13:15-16

Then Manoah said to the Angel of YHVH, "Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You." And the Angel of YHVH said to Manoah, "Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to YHVH." (For Manoah did not know He [was] the Angel of YHVH.)

Judges (Jueces) 13:17-18

Then Manoah said to the Angel of YHVH, "What [is] Your name, that when Your words come [to pass] we may honor You?"

And the Angel of YHVH said to him, "Why do you

ask My name, seeing it [is] wonderful?"

Judges (Jueces) 13:19-20

So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to YHVH. And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on-- it happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar--the Angel of YHVH ascended in the flame of the altar! When Manoah and his wife saw [this], they fell on their faces to the ground.

Judges (Jueces) 13:22-23

And Manoah said to his wife, "We shall surely die, because we have seen Elohim!"

But his wife said to him, "If YHVH had desired to kill us, He would not have accepted a burnt offering and a grain offering from our hands, nor would He have shown us all these [things], nor would He have told us [such things] as these at this time." (Other connections?)

Genesis 32:29-30

Then Jacob asked, saying, "Tell [me] Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why [is] it [that] you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there. So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: "For I have seen Elohim face to face, and my life is preserved."

(Like Esau's face- Another example?)

And the Angel of YHVH appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush [was] not consumed.

So when YHVH saw that he turned aside to look, Elohim called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."

Moreover He said, "I [am] the Elohim of your father--the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon Elohim. (Standing on Holy Ground?) (Bush or Angel is Elohim??)

Genesis 18:1-2

Then YHVH appeared to him by the terebinth trees of Mamre, as he was sitting in the tent door in the heat of the day.

So he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing by him; and when he saw [them], he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the ground.

Genesis 18:21-22

"I will go down now and see whether they have done altogether according to the outcry against it that has come to Me; and if not, I will know."

Then the men turned away from there and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before YHVH.

(2 angels enter Sodom)

"So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites."

Exodus (Exodo) 23:20-22

"Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; for My name [is] in Him. But if you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries."

Numbers (Numeros) 22:34-35

And Balaam said to the Angel of YHVH, "I have sinned, for I did not know You stood in the way against me. Now therefore, if it displeases You, I will turn back." Then the Angel of YHVH said to Balaam, "Go with the men, but only the word that I speak to you, that you shall speak." So Balaam went with the princes of Balak.

"For My Angel will go before you and bring you in to the Amorites and the Hittites and the Perizzites and the Canaanites and the Hivites and the Jebusites; and I will cut them off."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:2

And you shall remember that YHVH your Elohim led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you [and] test you, to know what [was] in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

Judges (Jueces) 2:1-2

Then the Angel of YHVH came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said: "I led you up from Egypt and brought you to the land of which I swore to your fathers; and I said, 'I will never break My covenant with you. And you shall make no covenant with the inhabitants of this land; you shall tear down their altars.' But you have not obeyed My voice. Why have you done this?" (Angel of YHVH & YHVH)

Judges (Jueces) 6:12

And the Angel of YHVH appeared to him, and said to him, "YHVH [is] with you, you mighty man of valor!"

Judges (Jueces) 6:14

Then YHVH turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?"

Judges (Jueces) 6:16-17

And YHVH said to him, "Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man." Then he said to Him, "If now I have found favor in Your sight, then show me a sign that it is You who talk with me."

Judges (Jueces) 6:18

"Do not depart from here, I pray, until I come to You and bring out my offering and set [it] before You." And He said, "I will wait until you come back."

Judges (Jueces) 6:21

Then the Angel of YHVH put out the end of the staff that [was] in His hand, and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; and fire rose out of the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. And the Angel of YHVH departed out of his sight. (Sign that YHVH talked with me) (They are echad-one?)

1 Chronicles (Cronicas) 21:15

And Elohim sent an angel to Jerusalem to destroy it. As he was destroying, YHVH looked and relented of the disaster, and said to the angel who was destroying, "It is enough; now restrain your hand." And the angel of YHVH stood by the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.

1 Chronicles (Cronicas) 21:16

Then David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of YHVH standing between earth and heaven, having in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. So David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell on their faces.

1 Chronicles (Cronicas) 21:27

So YHVH commanded the angel, and he returned his sword to its sheath.

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:8

For He said, "Surely they [are] My people, Children [who] will not lie." So He became their Savior.

(Angel who redeemed me?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:9

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the Angel of His Presence saved them; in His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bore them and carried them all the days of old.

- Melech Tzadek- came to meet Abraham- I swore to YHVH
- Abraham to his servant- an angel will go before you
- Jacob meets with angels when returning from Laban

Angel of YHVH (Presence) like Messiah?

John (Juan) 14:7-8

"If you had known me, you would have known my Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."

John (Juan) 14:9-10

Yeshua said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known me, Philip? He who has seen me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own [authority]; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works."

John (Juan) 14:11

"Believe me that I [am] in the Father and the Father in me, or else believe me for the sake of the works themselves."

John (Juan) 14:24

"He who does not love me does not keep my words; and the word which you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me."

John (Juan) 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim.

John (Juan) 1:14

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
