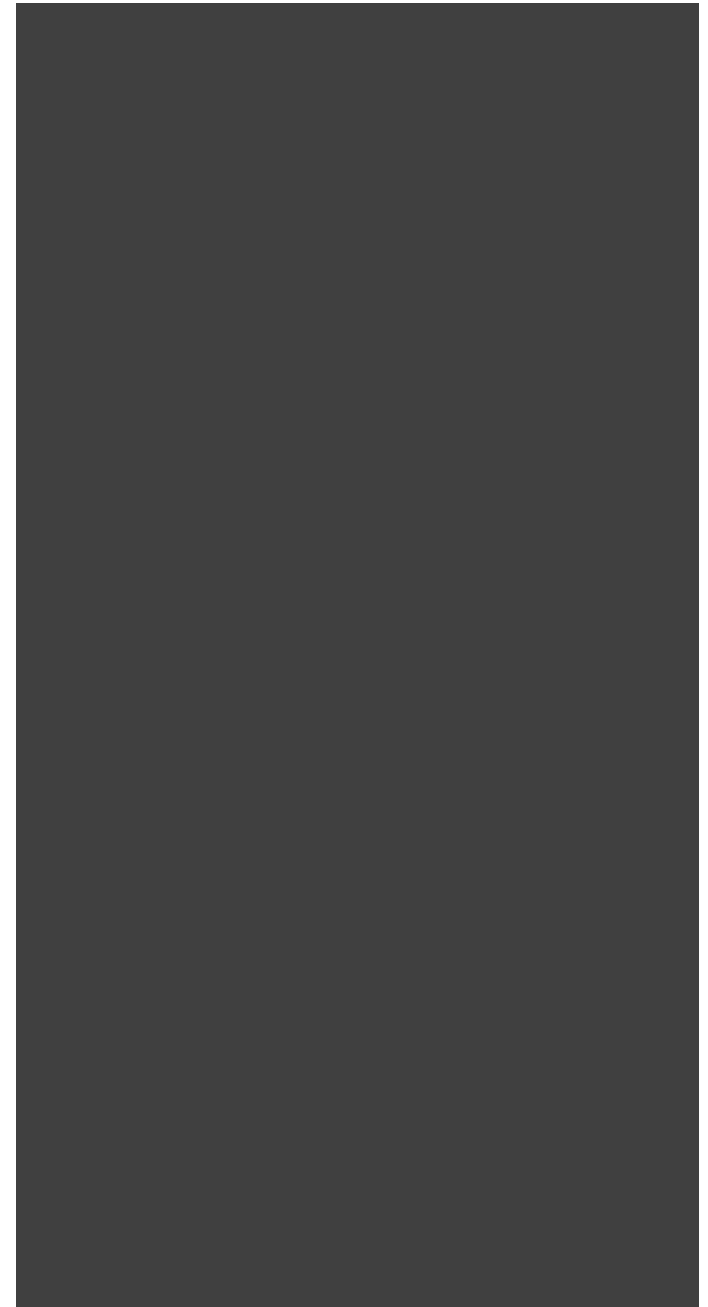

Leviticus 6:1-2

God spoke to Moses, telling him to relate the following instructions to Aaron and his descendants: This is the law of the burnt offering. The burnt offering shall remain on the altar's hearth all night until morning, so that the altar's fires can be ignited with it

Burnt Offerings

- Kept on the hearth (plate/top of altar) all night
- The priest had to put on special garments to take the ashes and put them beside the altar
- The priest would change garments and move the ashes to a clean place outside the camp
- The fire on the altar had to burn continually, it was not to go out
- The priest had to burn wood on the altar every morning lay the burnt offering in order and burn the fat of the peace offerings on the altar

Genesis 8:20

Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

Genesis 22:1-2

Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you."

Genesis 22:8

Abraham said, "God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." So the two of them walked on together.

Exodus 20:24

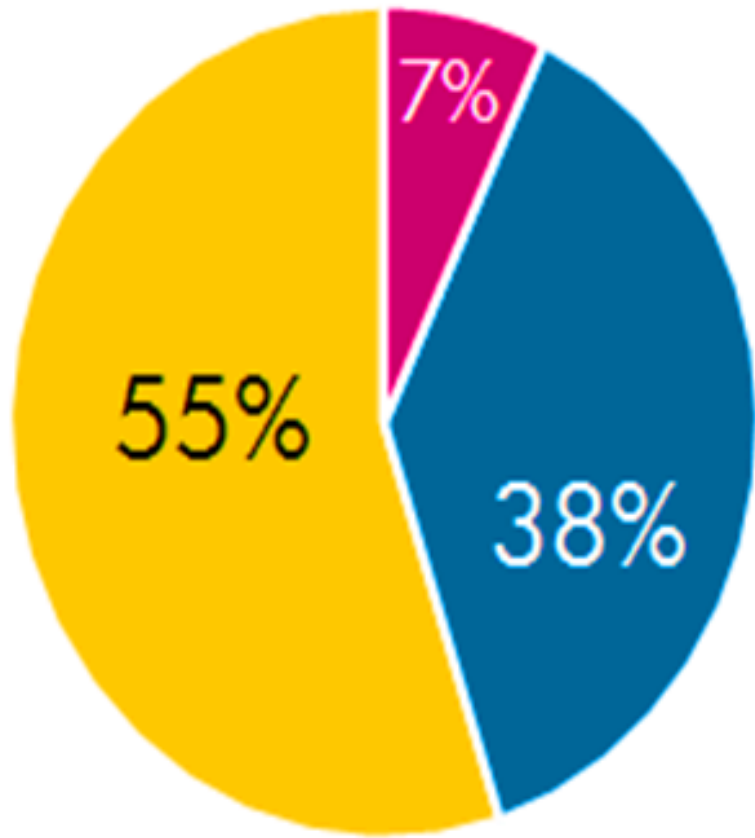
'You shall make an altar of earth for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your peace offerings, your sheep and your oxen; in every place where I cause My name to be remembered, I will come to you and bless you.

Leviticus 6:12

'The fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it. It shall not go out, but the priest shall burn wood on it every morning; and he shall lay out the burnt offering on it, and offer up in smoke the fat portions of the peace offerings on it.
