Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17

When he had been mikvahed, Y'hoshua
came up immediately from the water;
and behold, the heavens were opened to
him, and he saw the Spirit of Elohim
descending like a dove and alighting
upon him.

And suddenly a voice [came] from
heaven, saying, **"This is My beloved Son,**
in whom I am well pleased."

Exodus (Exodo) 12:1-2

And YHVH spoke unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,
“This month [shall be] unto you the beginning of months: it [shall be] the first month of the year to you.”
(In Egypt-New beginning)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:5-6

“Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take [it] from the sheep or from the goats.

Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. **Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight.”**

Exodus (Exodo) 12:8

“Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, **with unleavened bread [and] with bitter [herbs] they shall eat it.**”

(Commanded to eat)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:14

“So this day shall be to you a **memorial**; and you shall keep it as a feast to YHVH throughout your generations. **You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.**”

Exodus (Exodo) 12:15

“Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. **On the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses.** For whoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel.”

(Don't eat of this tree)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:20

“You shall eat nothing leavened; **in all
your dwellings you shall eat
unleavened bread.”**

(What is leaven?)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:33-34

And the Egyptians urged the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste. For they said, "We [shall] all [be] dead."

So **the people took their dough before it was leavened,** having their kneading bowls bound up in their clothes on their shoulders.

Exodus (Exodo) 12:38-39

A mixed multitude went up with them
also, and flocks and herds--a great deal of
livestock.

And they baked unleavened cakes of the
dough which they had brought out of
Egypt; for it was not leavened, because
they were driven out of Egypt and could
not wait, nor had they prepared
provisions for themselves. (Trust Him-
Renewed relationship-Not them)

Exodus (Exodo) 13:7-8

"Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days. And no leavened bread shall be seen among you, nor shall leaven be seen among you in all your quarters.

And you shall tell your son in that day, saying, '[This is done] because of what YHVH did for me when I came up from Egypt.'"

Exodus (Exodo) 13:9

"It shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a memorial between your eyes, **that YHVVH's law may be in your mouth;** for with a strong hand YHVVH has brought you out of Egypt."

Exodus (Exodo) 16:3

And the children of Israel said to them,
"Oh, that we had died by the hand of
YHVH in the land of Egypt, when we sat
by the pots of meat [and] when we ate
bread to the full! For you have brought us
out into this wilderness to kill this whole
assembly with hunger."

Exodus (Exodo) 16:4

Then YHVH said to Moses, "Behold, I will rain **bread** from heaven for you.

And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, **that I may test them, whether they will walk in My law or not.**"

Exodus (Exodo) 16:13-14

So it was that quails came up at evening and covered the camp, and in the morning the dew lay all around the camp.

And when the layer of dew lifted, there, on the surface of the wilderness, was a small round substance, [as] fine as frost on the ground.

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:1-2

"Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak;
And hear, O earth, the words of my
mouth.

Let my teaching drop as the rain, **My
speech distill as the dew,** As raindrops
on the tender herb, and as showers
on the grass."
(What is dew?)

Exodus (Exodo) 16:15

So when the children of Israel saw [it], they said to one another, "What is it?" For they did not know what it [was]. And Moses said to them, "**This [is] the bread which YHVH has given you to eat.**"

Exodus (Exodo) 16:19-20

And Moses said, "Let no one leave any of it till morning."

Notwithstanding they did not heed Moses. **But some of them left part of it until morning, and it bred worms and stank.** And Moses was angry with them.

(Follow my Law= trust Him, Was it leavened?)

Exodus (Exodo) 16:21

So they gathered it every morning,
every man according to his need. And
when the sun became hot, it melted.
(Seeds on path-temporary-not throw
pearls to swine?)

Exodus (Exodo) 16:31

And the house of Israel called its name Manna. And it [was] like white coriander seed, **and the taste of it [was] like wafers [made] with honey.**

(Ps. 119:103 Your words are sweet to the taste, sweeter than honey.)

Then Moses said, "This [is] the thing which YHVH has commanded: '**Fill an omer with it, to be kept for your generations, that they may see the bread with which I fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you out of the land of Egypt.'** "

As YHVH commanded Moses, so Aaron laid it up before the Testimony,
to be kept.

(Why connecting Manna to

Exodus (Exodo) 16:35

And the children of Israel ate manna
forty years, until they came to an
inhabited land; **they ate manna until**
they came to the border of the land
of Canaan.

(40 years, no leavening? What was 12
loaves of show bread made of in
wilderness? Priests eat what when
they serve?)

What does the Manna
represent?

What does Y'hoshua teach
about this?

John (Juan) 6:30-31

Therefore they said to Him, "What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do?"

Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, '**He** gave them bread from heaven to eat.'"

(Who is He? Is he the prophet like Moses? Signs?)

John (Juan) 6:32-33

Then Y'hoshua said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread from heaven.**

For the bread of Elohim is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

John (Juan) 6:34-35

Then they said to him, “Rabbi (Lord),
give us this bread always.”

And Yeshua said to them, **“I am the
bread of life.** He who comes to me
shall never hunger, and he who
believes in me shall never thirst.”

(Wilderness- Physical?)

John (Juan) 6:38, 40

"For I have come down from heaven,
not to do my own will, but the will of
Him who sent me.

And this is the will of Him who sent
me, that everyone who sees (eyes to
see) the Son and believes in Him may
have everlasting life; and I will raise
him up at the last day."

John (Juan) 6:41-42

The Jews then complained about him, because he said, "I am the bread which came down from heaven."

And they said, "Is not this Yeshua, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that he says, **'I have come down from heaven'?**"

John (Juan) 6:44-45

"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by Elohim.'

Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me."

(Is. 54, Jer. 31, Who is Son of Man?)

John (Juan) 6:47-48

"Most assuredly, I say to you, **he who believes** (in Me) has everlasting life.

I am the bread of life."

(What must I do to have eternal life?)

John (Juan) 6:49-50

"Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead.

This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die."

John (Juan) 6:51-52

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread (lechem) that I shall give is my flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world."

The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us [his] flesh to eat?"

John (Juan) 6:55-56

"For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him."

(Ezek. 37:4 prophesy to the bones,
"Hear the word of YHVH.")

John (Juan) 6:57-58

"As the living Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on me will live because of me.

This is the bread which came down from heaven--not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. **He who eats this bread will live forever."**

John (Juan) 6:59-60

These things he said in the synagogue
as he taught in Capernaum.

Therefore many of his disciples, when they heard [this], said, **"This is a hard saying; who can understand it?"**

John (Juan) 6:61-62

When Yeshua knew in himself that his disciples complained about this, he said to them, "Does this offend you?"

[What] then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where he was before?"

(Where was he before?)

John (Juan) 6:63

"It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and [they] are life."

(What are we feeding when we eat the bread of life?)

John (Juan) 6:66-68

From that [time] many of his disciples went back and walked with him no more.

Then Y'hoshua said to the twelve,
"Do you also want to go away?"

But Simon Peter answered him,
"Lord, to whom shall we go? You have
the words of eternal life."

John (Juan) 6:69

“Also we have come to believe and know that you are Anointed, the Son of the living Elohim.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:2

"And you shall remember that YHVH your Elohim led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you [and] test you, to know what [was] in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:3

"So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every [word] that proceeds from the mouth of YHVH."

(This is our life, tree of life)

Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17

And there appeared unto them
cloven tongues like as of fire, and it

them utterance.
