Matthew (Mateo) 16:13-15

When Yeshua came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, **"Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?"**

So they said, "Some [say] John the Immerser, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"

(Restore people-watchmen-Kinsman Redeemers)

Matthew (Mateo) 16:16-17

Simon Peter answered and said, "**You are the Anointed (Messiah), the Son of the living Elohim.**"

Y'hoshua answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed [this] to you, but my Father who is in heaven."
(Other verses?)

John (Juan) 3:14

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent
in the wilderness, even so must the
Son of Man be lifted up."

(On pole- People look up to be saved
from snake bite-Poison)

Matthew (Mateo) 17:22-23

Now while they were staying in Galilee, Yeshua said to them, "**The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill him, and the third day he will be raised up.**" And they were exceedingly sorrowful.

Matthew (Mateo) 20:18

"Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem,
and the Son of Man will be betrayed to
the chief priests and to the scribes; and
they will condemn him to death."

(Vineyard- Send His son- take him out
and kill)

Matthew (Mateo) 20:25-27

But Yeshua called them to [himself] and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. **And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave—"**

Matthew (Mateo) 20:28

“Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many.”

Matthew (Mateo) 12:8

“**For the Son of Man** is Lord even of
the Shabbat.”

Matthew (Mateo) 25:31

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the holy messengers (angels) with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory."

Matthew (Mateo) 19:28

So Y'hoshua said to them, "Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration,

Genesis 1:26

Then Elohim said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, **over all the earth** and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

(Son of Elohim)

Genesis 1:27-28

So Elohim created man in His [own] image; in the image of Elohim He created him; male and female He created them.

Then Elohim blessed them, and Elohim said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; **fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.**"

Genesis 2:2-3

And on the seventh day Elohim
ended His work which He had done,
and He rested on the seventh day
from all His work which He had done.
Then **Elohim blessed the seventh day**
and sanctified it, because in it He
rested from all His work which Elohim
had created and made.

Genesis 2:5

Before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For YHVH Elohim had not caused it to rain on the earth, and [there was] **no man to till the ground.**

(No one responsible)

Genesis 2:6-7

A mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground.

And YHVH Elohim formed man [of] the dust of the ground, **and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life;** and man became a living being.

Genesis 2:8

YHVH Elohim planted a garden eastward in Eden, and there He put the man whom He had formed.

(What purpose?)

Genesis 2:15-17

Then YHVH Elohim took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.

And YHVH Elohim commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." (What else are we to keep?)

"Remember the Shabbat day, to keep
it holy.

Six days you shall labor and do all
your work,
but the seventh day [is] the Shabbat
of YHVH your Elohim. [In it] you shall
do no work: you, nor your son, nor
your daughter, nor your male servant,
nor your female servant, nor your
cattle, nor your stranger who [is]
within your gates."

Exodus (Exodo) 20:11

"For [in] six days YHVH made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that [is] in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore YHVH blessed the Shabbat day and hallowed it."

Exodus (Exodo) 19:5-6

“Now therefore, if you will indeed **obey My voice and keep My covenant,** then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth [is] Mine.

And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These [are] the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Genesis 2:21-22

And YHVH Elohim caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his side (ribs), and closed up the flesh in its place.

Then the side (rib) which YHVH Elohim had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.

Genesis 3:14-15

So YHVH Elohim said to the serpent:

"Because you have done this, you [are] cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life. And

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife,
and have eaten from the tree of
which I commanded you, saying, 'You
shall not eat of it': **Cursed [is] the
ground for your sake; In toil you shall
eat [of] it all the days of your life.**"

Genesis 3:19

“In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground (earth), for out of it you were taken; for dust you [are], and to dust you shall return.”

(Dust return to the earth and the Spirit returns to Elohim who gave it.)
(Son of Man-Son of Elohim)

Genesis 3:16

To the woman He said: "I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you shall bring forth children; your desire [shall be] for your husband, and **he shall rule over you.**"

(Kinsman Redeemer?)

Genesis 3:23-24

Therefore YHVH Elohim sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

So He drove out the man; and **He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.** (If Adam is Firstborn- Kinsman redeemer, then his seed would be heir to his kingdom and responsible for restoration-Go back to Eden) (1st Son of Man?)

Genesis 4:1-2

Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain (buy, redeem), and said, "I have acquired a man from YHVH."

Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel (Breath). Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, **but Cain was a tiller of the ground.**

Genesis 4:3-4

And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to YHVH.

Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And **YHVH respected Abel and his offering.**

(Choose next leader-Ruler?)

Genesis 4:7-8

"If you do well, will you not be accepted (blessed)? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire [is] for you, **but you should rule over it."**

Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

(Am I my brother's keeper?)

Matthew (Mateo) 23:31-33

"Therefore you are witnesses against yourselves that you are sons of those who murdered the prophets.

Fill up, then, the measure of your fathers' [guilt].

Serpents, brood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of Gehenna?"

"Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes:
[some] of them you will kill and crucify, and [some] of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city, that on you may come all the righteous blood shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple

Genesis 4:25

And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son and named him Seth (appoint), "For Elohim has appointed another seed for me instead of Abel, whom Cain killed."

(Child to replace Abel and become the "Son of Man")
