## Numbers (Numeros) 4:21-7:89

וַיְדַבֵּר יְהוָה אֶל־מֹשֶׁה לֵאמֹר: וְשֵׂא אֶת־רֹאשׁ  
בְּנֵי גֵרְשׁוֹן אִם־הֵם לְבֵית אֲבֹתָם לְמִשְׁפּוֹתָם: מִבֶּן

Then YHVH spoke to Moses, saying:  
"Also **take (obtain)** a census of the sons of  
Gershon, by their fathers' house, by their  
families."

## Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17

When he had been mikvahed, Y'hoshua came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and **he saw the Spirit of Elohim descending like a dove and alighting upon him.**

And suddenly a voice [came] from heaven, saying, **"This is My beloved Son,** in whom I am well pleased (He is Good)."

## Genesis 2:5

Before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For YHVH Elohim had not caused it to rain on the earth, and [there was] **no man to till the ground.**  
(No one responsible)

## Genesis 2:6-7

A mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground.

And YHVH Elohim formed man [of] the dust of the ground, **and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life;** and man became a living being.

## Genesis 2:8

YHVH Elohim planted a garden eastward in Eden, and there He put the man whom He had formed.

(What purpose?)

## Genesis 2:15-17

Then YHVH Elohim took the man and put him in the garden of Eden **to tend and keep it.**

And YHVH Elohim commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat;

but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

(What else are we to keep?)

## Genesis 3:17

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': **Cursed [is] the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat [of] it all the days of your life.**"



## Genesis 3:19

“In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground (earth), for out of it you were taken; for dust you [are], and to dust you shall return.”

(Dust returns to the earth and the Spirit returns to Elohim who gave it.)

(Son of Man-Son of Elohim)

## Genesis 3:16

To the woman He said: "I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you shall bring forth children; your desire [shall be] for your husband, and **he shall rule over you (be responsible for you)."**

## Genesis 3:23-24

Therefore YHVH Elohim sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.

## Genesis 3:14-15

So YHVH Elohim said to the serpent:  
"Because you have done this, you [are]  
cursed more than all cattle, and more  
than every beast of the field; on your  
belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust  
all the days of your life. **And I will put**  
**enmity between you and the woman,**  
**and between your seed and her Seed; He**  
**shall bruise your head, and you shall**  
bruise his heel." (2 seeds)

## Genesis 4:25

And Adam knew his wife again, and **she bore a son** and named him Seth, "For Elohim has appointed **another seed** for me instead of Abel, whom Cain killed."

## Genesis 6:1-2

Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, that **the sons of Elohim saw the daughters of men, that they [were] beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose.**

(2 seeds)

## Genesis 6:4-5

There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of Elohim came in to the daughters of men and they bore [children] to them.

Those [were] the mighty men who [were] of old, men of renown. Then YHVH saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] **every intent of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.**



## Genesis 8:21

And YHVH smelled a soothing aroma. Then YHVH said in His heart, "I will never again curse the ground for man's sake, although the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; nor will I again destroy every living thing as I have done."

## Genesis 8:22

While the earth remains, **seedtime and harvest**, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease.

(Opposites-earth-dust-seed time to harvest-for his good)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 27:9-10

"The heart [is] deceitful above all [things], And desperately wicked; Who can know it?

I, YHVH, search the heart, [I] test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, **According to the fruit of his doings.**"

(Heart, fruit)

## Matthew (Mateo) 13:18-19

“Therefore hear the parable of the sower:

When anyone **hears the word** of the kingdom, and does not understand [it], then the wicked [one] comes and snatches away **what was sown in his heart.** This is he who received seed by the wayside.”

(Ground = Heart, Word = Seed)

Matthew (Mateo) 13:20-21

"But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who **hears the word** and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For **when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.**"

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:2

“And you shall remember that YHVH your Elohim led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you [and] test you, **to know what [was] in your heart,** whether you would keep His commandments or not.”



## Matthew (Mateo) 13:22

"Now **he who received seed** among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches **choke the word**, and **he becomes unfruitful.**"

## Leviticus (Levitico) 19:19

"Keep my decrees. Do not mate different kinds of animals. **Do not plant your field with two kinds of seed.** Do not wear clothing woven of two kinds of material."  
(Seeds = words/ accept Satan's words-weeds?)

Matthew (Mateo) 13:23

"But he who received seed on the good ground is **he who hears the word and understands [it]**, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty."

(Many more seeds-descendants/words,  
children-physical-spiritual)

## Matthew (Mateo) 13:24-25

Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way."

Matthew (Mateo) 13:30

“Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, ‘First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, **but gather the wheat into my barn.**’” (Enmity between your seed and her seed)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:18

“So that there may not be among you man or woman or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from YHVH our Elohim, to go [and] serve the elohim of these nations, and that there may not be among you a root bearing bitterness or wormwood;”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:19

“And so it may not happen, when he hears the words of this curse, that he blesses himself in his heart, saying, 'I shall have peace, even though I follow the dictates of my heart'--as though the drunkard (Watered ground) could be included with the sober (Dry ground).”

## Numbers (Numeros) 5:16-17

“And the priest shall bring her near, and set her before YHVH.

The priest shall take holy water in an earthen vessel, and **take some of the dust that is on the floor of the tabernacle and put [it] into the water.”**



## Numbers (Numeros) 5:18

“Then the priest shall stand the woman before YHVH, uncover the woman's head, and put the offering for remembering in her hands, which [is] the grain offering of jealousy. And **the priest shall have in his hand the bitter water that brings a curse.**”

## Numbers (Numeros) 5:21-22

“Then the priest shall put the woman under the oath of the curse, and he shall say to the woman—‘YHVH make you a curse and an oath among your people, when YHVH makes your thigh rot and your belly swell; and may this water that causes the curse go into your stomach, and make [your] belly swell and [your] thigh rot.’ Then the woman shall say, ‘Amen, so be it.’”

## Numbers (Numeros) 5:23-24

“Then the priest shall write these curses in a book, and he shall scrape [them] off into the bitter water.

And he shall make the woman drink the bitter water that brings a curse, and the water that brings the curse shall enter her [to become] bitter.”

## Numbers (Numeros) 5:25-26

“Then the priest shall take the grain offering of jealousy from the woman's hand, shall wave the offering before YHVH, and bring it to the altar; and the priest shall take a handful of the offering, as its memorial portion, burn [it] on the altar, and afterward make the woman drink the water.”

## Numbers (Numeros) 5:28

“But if the woman has not defiled herself, and is clean, then she shall be free and may conceive children.”

(Good Ground)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 6:4-6

“Hear, O Israel: YHVH our Elohim, YHVH  
[is] one!

You shall love YHVH your Elohim with **all  
your heart**, with all your soul, and with all  
your strength.

And **these words which I command you  
today shall be in your heart.”**

(Teach them to your children)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 11:18

“Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.”

(Why?)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:31-32

“Cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, **and get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit.** For why should you die, O house of Israel?

For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies,” says YHVH Elohim.

“Therefore turn and live!”



## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 36:24-25

"For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land.

Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; **I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols."**

(Idolatry=adultery)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 36:26-27

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do [them]."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 36:28

"Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; **you shall be My people, and I will be your Elohim.**"

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 36:33-34

Thus says YHVH Elohim: "On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will also enable [you] to dwell in the cities, and the ruins shall be rebuilt.

**The desolate land shall be tilled instead of lying desolate in the sight of all who pass by."**

(Circumcise Heart)

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 36:35-36

"So they will say, **'This land that was desolate has become like the garden of Eden;** and the wasted, desolate, and ruined cities [are now] fortified [and] inhabited.'

Then the nations which are left all around you shall know that I, YHVH, have rebuilt the ruined places **[and] planted what was desolate.** I, YHVH, have spoken [it], and I will do [it]."

## Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17
