Luke (Lucas) 3:22-23

And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "**You are My beloved Son; in you I am well pleased.**"

Now Yeshua himself began [his ministry at] about thirty years of age, being [the] son of Joseph, the son of Heli... (Seed-Son of David)

2 Samuel 7:12-13

"When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever."
(I will be his Father and he My son)

Matthew (Mateo) 13:24-25

Another parable he put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; but while men slept, **his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat** and went his way."

Matthew (Mateo) 13:30

“Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, ‘First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, **but gather the wheat into my barn.**’” (Enmity between your seed and her seed)

Genesis 3:13-14

And YHVH Elohim said to the woman,
"What [is] this you have done?" The
woman said, "The serpent deceived me,
and I ate."

So YHVH Elohim said to the serpent:
"Because you have done this, you [are]
cursed more than all cattle, and more
than every beast of the field; **on your
belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust**
all the days of your life." (They are our
bread)

Genesis 3:15

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”

Genesis 4:25-26

And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son and named him Seth, "For Elohim has appointed another seed for me instead of Abel, whom Cain killed."

And as for Seth, to him also a son was born; and he named him Enosh. Then [men] began to call on the name of YHVH.

Genesis 6:1-2

Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, that **the sons of Elohim saw the daughters of men,** that they [were] beautiful; **and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose.**

Genesis 6:3

And YHVH said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, **for he [is] indeed flesh (dust);** yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

Genesis 6:4

There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of Elohim came in to the daughters of men and they bore [children] to them.

Those [were] the mighty men who [were] of old, men of renown.

Genesis 6:5, 7

Then **YHVH saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every intent of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.**

So YHVH said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."

Genesis 6:8-9

But Noah found grace in the eyes of YHVH.
This is the generations of Noah. **Noah
was a just man, perfect in his
generations. Noah walked with
Elohim.**

And Noah begot three sons: Shem,
Ham, and Japheth. (Canaan cursed to
serve.)

Numbers (Numeros) 13:32

And they gave the children of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, "The land through which we have gone as spies [is] a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people whom we saw in it [are] men of [great] stature."

(Weeds)

Numbers (Numeros) 13:33

“There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 19:1-2

"Hear, O Israel: You [are] to cross over the Jordan today, and go in to dispossess nations greater and mightier than yourself, cities great and fortified up to heaven, a people great and tall, the descendants of the Anakim, whom you know, and [of whom] you heard [it said], 'Who can stand before the descendants of Anak?'"

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 3:11

"For only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of the giants. Indeed his bedstead [was] an iron bedstead. ([Is] it not in Rabbah of the people of Ammon?) Nine cubits [is] its length and four cubits its width, according to the standard cubit."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 3:1-2

"Then we turned and went up the road to Bashan; and Og king of Bashan came out against us, he and all his people, to battle at Edrei. And YHVH said to me, 'Do not fear him, for I have delivered him and all his people and his land into your hand; you shall do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon.'"

(Samson - Israel's champion)

1 Samuel 17:2-3

And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and they encamped in the Valley of Elah, and drew up in battle array against the Philistines.

The Philistines stood on a mountain on one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side, with a valley between them.

(Separated)

1 Samuel 17:4, 8

And a champion went out from the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, from Gath, whose height [was] six cubits and a span.

Then he stood and cried out to the armies of Israel, and said to them, "Why have you come out to line up for battle? [Am] I not a Philistine, and you the servants of Saul? Choose a man for yourselves, and let him come down to me." (head and shoulders above)

1 Samuel 17:9-10

"If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants.

But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us."

And the Philistine said, "I defy the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together."

(Who do we serve?)

1 Samuel 17:11

When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were
dismayed and greatly afraid.
(Like people after report of spies)

1 Samuel 17:16

And the Philistine drew near and
presented himself forty days,
morning and evening.

(Like spies)

1 Samuel 17:20-21

So David rose early in the morning, left the sheep with a keeper, and took [the things] and went as Jesse had commanded him. And he came to the camp as the army was going out to the fight and shouting for the battle.

For Israel and the Philistines had drawn up in battle array, army against army.

1 Samuel 17:22-23

And David left his supplies in the hand of the supply keeper, ran to the army, and came and greeted his brothers.

Then as he talked with them, there was the champion, the Philistine of Gath, Goliath by name, coming up from the armies of the Philistines; and he spoke according to the same words. So David heard [them].

And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, fled from him and were dreadfully afraid (Saul?).

So the men of Israel said, "Have you seen this man who has come up? Surely he has come up to defy Israel; and it shall be [that] the man who kills him the king will enrich with great riches, will give him his daughter, and give his father's house exemption [from taxes] in Israel."

“Will you give him his daughter?”

1 Samuel 17:26

Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach (shame) from Israel? For who [is] this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living Elohim?"

(Caleb- from tribe of Judah, Let us go up and attack for Yah has given them into our hands- Our bread)

1 Samuel 17:34-35

But David said to Saul, "Your servant used to keep his father's sheep, and when a lion or a bear came and took a lamb out of the flock, I went out after it and struck it, and delivered [the lamb] from its mouth; and when it arose against me, I caught [it] by its beard, and struck and killed it." (Rev.

13: feet of bear, mouth of lion-
dragon gave throne and authority)

1 Samuel 17:36-37

"Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living Elohim."

Moreover David said, "YHVH, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear (beasts), He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." And Saul said to David, "Go, and YHVH be with you!"

1 Samuel 17:40

Then he took his staff in his hand;
and he chose for himself five smooth
stones from the brook, and put them
in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which
he had, and his sling was in his hand.
And he drew near to the Philistine.

1 Samuel 17:43-44

So the Philistine said to David, "[Am] I a dog, that you come to me with sticks (Staff- Moses)?" **And the Philistine cursed David by his elohim.**

And the Philistine said to David, "Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!"

1 Samuel 17:45

Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of YHVH of hosts, the Elohim of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied."

1 Samuel 17:46

"This day YHVH will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a (one) Elohim in Israel."

1 Samuel 17:47

“Then all this assembly shall know
that YHVH does not save with sword
and spear;

for the battle [is] YHVH's,
and He will give you into our hands.”
(Stone struck head)

1 Samuel 17:51

Therefore David ran and stood over the Philistine, took his sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him, and cut off his head with it. And when the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they fled.
(revenge with Saul- Saints)

1 Samuel 17:54

And David took the head of the
Philistine and brought it to
Jerusalem, but he put his armor in his
tent.

John (Juan) 19:17-18

And he, bearing his tree, went out to
a place called [the Place] of a Skull,
which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha,
where they crucified him, and two
others with him, one on either side,
and Y'hoshua in the center.
(Seed into woman & earth)

Numbers (Numeros) 21:5-6

And the people spoke against Elohim and against Moses: "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For [there is] no food and no water, and our soul loathes this worthless bread."

So YHVH sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and many of the people of Israel died.

Numbers (Numeros) 21:7-8

Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against YHVH and against you; pray to YHVH that He take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people. Then YHVH said to Moses, "Make a fiery [serpent], and set it on a pole; and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live."

Numbers (Numeros) 21:9

So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.
(Looked for Yah's salvation)

Romans (Romanos) 16:20

And the Elohim of peace will crush
Satan under your feet shortly...

1 Corinthians (Corintios) 5:5

Deliver such a one to Satan for the
destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be
saved in the day of YHVH [Yeshua.]
(Eat the dust)

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 19:11, 13

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And he who sat on him [was] called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war.

He [was] clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of Elohim.

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 19:14-15

And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed him on white horses.

Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And he himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty Elohim.

Revelation (Apocalypse) 19:17-18

Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great Elohim, that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all [people], free and slave, both small and great."

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 19:19, 21

And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him who sat on the horse and against His army.

And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 20:7-8

Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison

and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number [is] as the sand of the sea.

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 20:9-10

They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. **And fire came down from Elohim out of heaven and devoured them.**

The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet [are]. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Revelation (Apocalipsis) 21:3-4

And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of Elohim [is] with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. Elohim Himself will be with them [and be] their Elohim.

And Elohim will wipe away every tear from their eyes; **there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying.** There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.
