# The Son

## Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17

When he had been mikvahed, Yeshua came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of Elohim descending like a dove and alighting upon him.

And suddenly a voice [came] from heaven, saying, **"This is My beloved Son,** in whom I am well pleased."

## John (Juan) 8:28-29

Then Yeshua said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am [He], and [that] **I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.**

And He who sent me is with me. The Father has not left me alone, **for I always do those things that please Him.**"

## John (Juan) 8:31-33

Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are my disciples indeed.

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

They answered him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How [can] You say, 'You will be made free'?"

## John (Juan) 8:34-36

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 46:16

Thus says YHVH Elohim: "If the prince gives a gift [of some] of his inheritance to any of his sons, **it shall belong to his sons; it is their possession by inheritance.**"

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 46:17

"But if he gives a gift of some of his inheritance to one of his servants, it shall be his until the year of liberty, after which it shall return to the prince. But his inheritance shall belong to his sons; it shall become theirs."

(Messiah's teaching?)



## Luke (Lucas) 15:17-19

"But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you, and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants."'"

## Luke (Lucas) 15:25-26

"Now his older son was in the field. **And as he came and drew near to the house,** he heard music and dancing.

So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant."

(Brother is alive and home- Killed the fatted calf)

Luke (Lucas) 15:28

"But he was angry and would not go in.  
Therefore his father came out and  
pleaded with him."

## Luke (Lucas) 15:29-30

“So he answered and said to [his] father,  
'Lo, these many years I have been serving  
you; I never transgressed your  
commandment at any time; and yet you  
never gave me a young goat, that I might  
make merry with my friends.

But as soon as this son of yours came,  
who has devoured your livelihood with  
harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.”

Luke (Lucas) 15:31

"And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with me, and all that I have is yours.'"

(Did he ever go into the house?)

Matthew (Mateo) 20:1-2

"For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard.

**Now when he had agreed with the laborers for a denarius a day,** he sent them into his vineyard."

## Matthew (Mateo) 20:8

"So when evening had come, the owner of the vineyard said to his steward, 'Call the laborers and give them [their] wages, beginning with the last to the first.'"

Matthew (Mateo) 20:10-11

"But when the first came, they  
supposed that they would receive  
more; and they likewise received  
each a denarius.

And when they had received [it], they  
complained against the landowner."



Matthew (Mateo) 20:12

“...saying, 'These last [men] have worked [only] one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.'”

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:24

But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked [man] does, **shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered;** because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die.

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:25

"Yet you say, 'The way of YHVH is not fair.'  
Hear now, O house of Israel, is it not  
My way which is fair, and your ways  
which are not fair?"

# Other Examples

- Some of those invited to the Wedding?
- 5 virgins
- Like to be called “Master, Lord, Father”
- “All the commandments I have kept from my youth.”
- “When didn’t we do these things?”

## John (Juan) 8:34-36

Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a servant (slave) of sin. And a servant does not abide in the house forever, [but] a son abides forever.

Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed."

## John (Juan) 8:39-40

They answered and said to him, "Abraham is our father." Yeshua said to them, **"If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham.** But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has told you the truth which I heard from Elohim. **Abraham did not do this."**

## Genesis 17:4-5

"As for me, behold, My covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations.

No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations."

(Who was circumcised?)

## Galatians (Galatas) 4:21-22

Tell me, you who desire to be under the law, do you not hear the law?

**For it is written that Abraham had two sons:** the one by a bondwoman, the other by a freewoman.



## Galatians (Galatas) 4:23

But he [who was] of the bondwoman was born according to the flesh, and he of the freewoman through promise.

(Gal. 5:all)

(Heart of the problem- problem of the heart?)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:10-11

When you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless YHVH your Elohim for the good land which He has given you.

Beware that you do not forget YHVH your Elohim by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today.

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:12-13

Lest--when you have eaten and are full, and have built beautiful houses and dwell in them; and [when] your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied.  
(Blessed for faithfulness???)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:14, 17

When your heart is lifted up, and you forget YHVH your Elohim who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; then you say in your heart, “My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 9:4

"Do not think in your heart, after YHVH your Elohim has cast them out before you, saying,

**'Because of my righteousness YHVH has brought me in to possess this land';** but [it is] because of the wickedness of these nations [that] YHVH is driving them out from before you."

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 9:5

It is not because of your righteousness or the  
uprightness of your heart [that] you go in to  
possess their land, but because of the wickedness  
of these nations [that] YHVH your Elohim drives  
them out from before you, and **that He may  
fulfill the word** which YHVH swore to your  
fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

(Examples of servants)

## Jeremiah (Jeremias) 25:9

“Behold, I will send and take all the families of the north,” says YHVH, “and Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, My servant, and will bring them against this land, against its inhabitants, and against these nations all around, and will utterly destroy them, and make them an astonishment, a hissing, and perpetual desolations.” (Dt. 28:36-52, 32:21,27)

## Numbers (Numeros) 22:12-13

And Elohim said to Balaam, "You shall not go with them; **you shall not curse the people, for they [are] blessed.**"

So Balaam rose in the morning and said to the princes of Balak, "Go back to your land, for YHVH has refused to give me permission to go with you."



## Numbers (Numeros) 22:18

Then Balaam answered and said to the servants of Balak, "Though Balak were to give me his house full of silver and gold, I could not go beyond the word of YHVH my Elohim, to do less or more."

## Numbers (Numeros) 22:20

And Elohim came to Balaam at night and said to him, "If the men come to call you, rise [and] go with them; but only the word which I speak to you--that you shall do."

## Numbers (Numeros) 22:20

And Elohim came to Balaam at night and said to him, "If the men come to call you, rise [and] go with them; but only the word which I speak to you--that you shall do."

(Donkey could see angel, speaks His words exactly.)

## Numbers (Numeros) 23:4-5

And Elohim met Balaam, and he said to Him,  
"I have prepared the seven altars, and I have  
offered on [each] altar a bull and a ram."  
Then YHVH put a word in Balaam's mouth,  
and said, "Return to Balak, and thus you shall  
speak."

## Numbers (Numeros) 24:1-2

Now when Balaam saw that it pleased YHVH to bless Israel, **he did not go as at other times, to seek to use sorcery,** but he set his face toward the wilderness.

And Balaam raised his eyes, and saw Israel encamped according to their tribes; and the Spirit of Elohim came upon him. (Eyes opened- word in his mouth- like donkey)

## Micah (Miqueas) 6:4-5

For I brought you up from the land of Egypt, I redeemed you from the house of bondage; And I sent before you Moses, Aaron, and Miriam.

O My people, **remember now What Balak king of Moab counseled, And what Balaam the son of Beor answered him, From Acacia Grove to Gilgal, That you may know the righteousness of YHVH.**

## Micah (Miqueas) 6:6-7

With what shall I come before YHVH, [And] bow myself before the High Elohim? Shall I come before Him with burnt offerings, With calves a year old? Will YHVH be pleased with thousands of rams, Ten thousand rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn [for] my transgression, The fruit of my body [for] the sin of my soul?

## Micah (Miqueas) 6:8

He has shown you, O man, what [is] good;

And **what does YHVH require of you** but to do

justly,

to love mercy,

And to walk humbly with your

Elohim?



## John (Juan) 8:28-29

Then Yeshua said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am [He], and [that] I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.

"Also the sons of the foreigner who join themselves to YHVH, to serve Him, and to love the authority (name) of YHVH, **to be His servants**--Everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, And holds fast My covenant—"

## Isaiah (Isaias) 56:7

“Even them I will bring to My holy mountain,  
And **make them joyful in My house of prayer.** Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [will be] accepted on My altar; for **My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.”**

## John (Juan) 8:41-42

"You do the deeds of your father." Then they said to him, "**We were not born of fornication; we have one Father--Elohim.**" Yeshua said to them, "If Elohim were your Father, you would love me, for I **proceeded forth** and came from Elohim; nor have I come of myself, but He sent me."

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:2

"And you shall remember that YHVH your Elohim led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, **to humble you [and] test you, to know what [was] in your heart,** whether you would keep His commandments or not."



## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:3

"So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every [word] that proceeds from the mouth of YHVH."
