# The Son

## Matthew (Mateo) 3:16-17

When he had been mikvahed, Yeshua came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of Elohim descending like a dove and alighting upon him.

And suddenly a voice [came] from heaven, saying,

**"This is My beloved Son,**  
in whom I am well pleased."

## Numbers (Numeros) 25:4

Then YHVH said to Moses, "Take all the leaders of the people and hang the offenders before YHVH, out in the sun, that the fierce anger of YHVH may turn away from Israel."

## Numbers (Numeros) 25:6

And indeed, one of the children of Israel came and presented (come near- offer) to his brethren a Midianite woman in the sight of Moses and in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who [were] **weeping at the door of the tabernacle of meeting.**

## Numbers (Numeros) 25:7-8

Now when Phinehas the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest (3<sup>rd</sup> generation), saw [it], he rose from among the congregation and took a javelin in his hand;

and **he went after the man of Israel into the tent and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her body.** So the plague was stopped among the children of Israel.

## Numbers (Numeros) 25:11

And those who died in the plague were twenty-four thousand.

“Phinehas the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, has turned back My wrath from the children of Israel, **because he was zealous with My zeal among them**, so that I did not consume the children of Israel in My zeal.”

## Numbers (Numeros) 25:12

"Therefore say, 'Behold, I give to him My covenant of peace; and it shall be to him and his descendants after him a covenant of an everlasting priesthood, because he was zealous for his Elohim, and made atonement for the children of Israel.' "

## Exodus (Exodo) 29:9

"And you shall gird them with sashes, Aaron and his sons, and put the hats on them. The priesthood shall be theirs for a perpetual statute.  
So you shall consecrate Aaron and his sons."

## Exodus (Exodo) 40:15

“You shall anoint them, as you anointed their father, **that they may minister to Me as priests;** for their anointing shall surely be an **everlasting priesthood** throughout their generations.”

## Leviticus (Levitico) 26:3

“If you walk in My statutes and keep My commandments, and perform them...”

## Leviticus (Levitico) 26:9

“For I will look on you favorably and make you fruitful, multiply you and confirm My covenant with you.”

## Jeremiah (Jeremias) 31:9

They shall come with weeping, and with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, in a straight way in which they shall not stumble; for I am a Father to

**Israel, and Ephraim [is] My firstborn.**

(Connects Israel to Ephraim, why?)

## Genesis 48:5

"And now your two sons, Ephraim (fruitful) and Manasseh (forget), who were born to you in the land of Egypt before I came to you in Egypt, **[are] mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine."**

(Bless your sons-May you be like Ephraim & Manasseh.)

## Isaiah (Isaias) 54:13

All your children [shall be] taught by YHVH, and  
**great [shall be] the peace of your**  
**children.**



# Covenant of Peace

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:18

“So that there may not be among you man or woman or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from YHVH our Elohim, to go [and] serve the Elohims of these nations, and that there may not be among you a root bearing bitterness or wormwood (Poison).”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:19

“And so it may not happen, when he hears the words of this curse, that he blesses himself in his heart, saying, 'I shall have peace, even though I follow the dictates of my heart'-- as though the drunkard could be included with the sober.”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 13:6, 8

“If your brother, the son of your mother, your son or your daughter, the wife of your bosom, or your friend who is as your own soul, secretly entices you, saying, ‘Let us go and serve other elohim,’ which you have not known, neither you nor your fathers, you shall not consent to him or listen to him, nor shall your eye pity him, nor shall you spare him or conceal him.”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 13:9-10

“But you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.

And you shall stone him with stones until he dies, because **he sought to entice you away from YHVH your Elohim**, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.”

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 13:17-18

“So none of the accursed things shall remain in your hand, that YHVH may turn from the fierceness of His anger and show you mercy, have compassion on you and multiply you, just as He swore to your fathers, because you have listened to the voice of YHVH your Elohim, to keep all His commandments which I command you today, to do [what is] right in the eyes of YHVH your Elohim.”

# Numbers (Numeros) 1:52-53

"The children of Israel shall pitch their tents,  
everyone by his own camp, everyone by his own  
standard, according to their armies;  
but the Levites shall camp around the tabernacle  
of the Testimony, that there may be no wrath on  
the congregation of the children of Israel; and the  
Levites shall keep charge of the tabernacle of the  
Testimony."

## Numbers (Numeros) 6:24-26

"YHVH bless you and keep you;

YHVH make His face shine upon you, and be  
gracious to you;

YHVH lift up His countenance upon you, **and**  
**give you peace."**



## Isaiah (Isaias) 9:7

"Of the increase of [His] government and peace [There will be] no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, **to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever.** The zeal of YHVH of hosts will perform this."

## Isaiah (Isaias) 53:5

But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he  
was] bruised for our iniquities; **the**  
**chastisement for our peace [was] upon**  
**him,** and by his stripes we are healed.  
(Obedience brings about the greatest Peace.)

## John (Juan) 3:14

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, **even so must the Son of Man be lifted up.**"

(On pole- 1<sup>st</sup> serpent, 2<sup>nd</sup> man and woman, then son of man-People look up to be saved from snake bite-Poison- bitterness & Wormwood)

Matthew (Mateo) 5:9

"Blessed [are] the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of Elohim."
