

Yom Kippur

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 50:4-5

"In those days and in that time," says YHVH, "The children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together; **with continual weeping they shall come, and seek YHVH their Elohim.**

They shall ask the way to Zion, with their faces toward it, [saying], 'Come and let us **join** ourselves to YHVH in a perpetual covenant that will not be forgotten.'" (Why?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 14:1

For YHVH will have mercy on Jacob, and will still choose Israel, and settle them in their own land. **The strangers will be joined with them**, and they will **cling (cleave)** to the house of Jacob.

Genesis 2:24

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and **they shall become one flesh.**"

Zechariah (Zacarias) 2:10-11

"Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and I will dwell in your midst," says YHVH. **Many nations shall be joined to YHVH in that day, and they shall become My people.** And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that YHVH of hosts has sent Me to you."

Isaiah (Isaias) 56:3

Numbers (Numeros) 18:1

Then **YHVH said to Aaron:** "You and your sons and your father's house with you shall bear the iniquity [related to] the sanctuary, and you and your sons with you shall bear the iniquity [associated with] your priesthood."

Numbers (Numeros) 18:2

"Also bring with you your brethren of the tribe of Levi, the tribe of your father, **that they may be joined with you** and serve you while you and your sons [are] with you before the tabernacle of witness."

Numbers (Numeros) 18:3-4

"They shall attend to your needs and all the needs of the tabernacle; but they shall not come near the articles of the sanctuary and the altar, lest they die--they and you also.

They shall be joined with you and attend to the needs of the tabernacle of meeting, for all the work of the tabernacle; but an outsider shall not come near you."

Numbers (Numeros) 1:53

"But the Levites shall camp around the tabernacle of the Testimony, that there may be no wrath on the congregation of the children of Israel; and **the Levites shall keep charge of the tabernacle of the Testimony.**"

Numbers (Numeros) 3:12-13

"Now behold, **I Myself have taken the Levites from among the children of Israel instead of every firstborn who opens the womb** among the children of Israel. Therefore the Levites shall be Mine, because all the firstborn [are] Mine. On the day that I struck all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, I sanctified to Myself all the firstborn in Israel, both man and beast. **They shall be Mine: I [am] YHVH."**

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:8

When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, when He separated the sons of Adam, he set the boundaries of the peoples **according to the number of the children of Israel.**

Numbers (Numeros) 25:1-3

"Now Israel remained in Acacia Grove, and the people began to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. They invited the people to the sacrifices of their Elohims, and the people ate and bowed down to their Elohims. So Israel was **joined** to Baal of Peor, and the anger of YHVH was aroused against Israel." (Golden Calf)

Luke (Lucas) 15:13-15

"And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together, journeyed to a far country, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living. But when he had spent all, there arose a severe famine in that land, and he began to be in want. Then he went and **joined** himself to a **citizen of that country,** and he sent him into his fields to feed swine."

1 Corinthians (Corintios) 6:15-16

"Do you not know that your bodies are members of Messiah? Shall I then take the members of Messiah and make [them] members of a harlot? Certainly not!

Or do you not know that he who is **joined** to a harlot is one body [with her]? For "the two," He says, **"shall become one flesh."**

1 Corinthians (Corintios) 6:17

"But he who is **joined** to the Lord is one spirit
with Him."

(Joined with YHVH/Word?)

John (Juan) 17:11

"Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, **keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.**" (Native born)

John (Juan) 17:20-21

"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that **they all may be one**, as You, Father, [are] in me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent me."

John (Juan) 17:22-23

"And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, **that they may be one just as We are one:** I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent me, and have loved them as You have loved me."

(2 groups Join to YHVH)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 19:10-11

“All of you stand today before YHVH your Elohim:
your leaders and your tribes and your elders and
your officers, all the men of Israel,
your little ones and your wives--also the stranger
who [is] in your camp, from the one who cuts your
wood to the one who draws your water.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 19:12-13

“That you may enter into covenant with YHVH your Elohim, and into His oath, which YHVH your Elohim makes with you today, that **He may establish you today as a people for Himself,** and [that] He may be Elohim to you, just as He has spoken to you, and just as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 19:14-15

"I make this covenant and this oath, not with **you alone**, but with [him] who stands here with us today before YHVH our Elohim, as well as with [him] who [is] not here with us today"

Ruth (Rut) 1:16-17

But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, [Or to] turn back from following after you; **for** wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people [shall be] my people, And your Elohim, my Elohim. Where you die, I will die, And there will I be buried. YHVH do so to me, and more also, If [anything but] death parts you and me."

Exodus (Exodo) 19:4-5

“Now therefore, **if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant,** then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth [is] Mine. And you shall be to Me a **kingdom of priests** and a holy nation.’ These [are] the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.”

Isaiah (Isaias) 66:1-2

Thus says YHVH: "Heaven [is] My throne, And earth [is] My footstool. Where [is] the house that you will build Me? And where [is] the place of My rest? For all those [things] My hand has made, And all those [things] exist," Says YHVH. **"But on this [one] will I look: on [him who is] poor and of a contrite spirit, and who trembles at My word."**
