Psalm (Salmos) 1:1-2

Blessed [is] the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
But **his delight [is] in the teachings (Torah) of YHVH**, and in His teaching (law) he meditates
day and night.

Psalm (Salmos) 1:3

He shall be like a tree **planted by the rivers of water**, that brings forth its fruit in its season,
whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever
he does shall prosper.

Genesis 13:8-9

So Abram said to Lot, "Please let there be no strife between you and me, and between my herdsmen and your herdsmen; for we [are] brethren. Is not the whole land before you? Please separate from me. If you take **the left**, then I will go to **the right**; or, if you go to the right, then I will go to the left."

Genesis 13:10-11

And Lot lifted his eyes and saw all the plain of Jordan, that **it [was] well watered everywhere**

(before YHVH destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah) **like the garden of YHVH, like the land of Egypt** as you go toward Zoar.

Then Lot chose for himself all the plain of Jordan, and Lot journeyed east. And they separated from each other.

Genesis 3:6

So when **the woman saw** that the tree [was] **good for food**, that it [was] **pleasant to the eyes**, and a tree desirable to make [one] wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

(Well watered?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 55:10

"For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but **water the earth**, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater,"

Isaiah (Isaias) 55:11

“So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] for which I sent it.”

(Like Garden, Like Egypt?)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 11:10

"For the land which you go to possess [is] not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered [it] by foot, as a vegetable garden."

(Shem vs. Ham)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 11:11

“But the land which you cross over to possess [is] a land of hills and valleys, **which drinks water from the rain of heaven.”**

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 11:12

“A land for which YHVH your Elohim cares; the eyes of YHVH your Elohim [are] always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.”

(Separate from Abram)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:14-15

"I make this covenant and this oath, not with you alone, but with [him] who stands here with us today before YHVH our Elohim, as well as with [him] who [is] not here with us today..."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:18

“So that there may not be among you man or woman or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from YHVH our Elohim, to go [and] serve the elohim of these nations, and that there may **not be among you** a root bearing bitterness or wormwood;”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:19

“And so it may not happen, when he hears the words of this curse, that he blesses himself in his heart, saying, 'I shall have peace, even though I follow the dictates of my heart'--**as though the drunkard could be included with the sober.**”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 29:19

"YHVH will change the rain of your land to powder and dust; from the heaven it shall come down on you until you are destroyed."

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:3-4

“If you walk in My statutes and keep My commandments, and perform them, then **I will give you rain in its season**, the land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.”

2 Peter (Pedro) 2:15, 17

They have forsaken the right way and gone astray, following the way of Balaam the [son] of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

These are wells without water, clouds carried by a tempest, for whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever.
