Genesis 12:1

Genesis 12:10

Now there was a famine in the land, and
Abram went down to Egypt to dwell there, **for**
the famine [was] severe in the land.

(Yah teaching?)

Genesis 12:13

“Please say you are my sister, that it may be well with me for your sake, **and that I may live because of you.**”

(Wife take charge and save him-trust who?)

(Origin of the idea?)

Genesis 20:13

"And it came to pass, **when Elohim caused me to wander from my father's house,** that I said to her, 'This [is] your kindness that you should do for me: in every place, wherever we go, say of me, "He [is] my brother." ' "

Genesis 12:16

He treated Abram well for her sake. He had
sheep, oxen, male donkeys, male and female
servants, female donkeys, and camels.

Genesis 13:2

Abram [was] very rich in livestock, in silver,
and in gold.

Genesis 13:14-15

And YHVH said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him: "Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are-- northward, southward, eastward, and westward;

for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever."

Genesis 13:17

Genesis 20:21

Now Abraham said of Sarah his wife, "She [is] my sister." And Abimelech king of Gerar sent and took Sarah.

Genesis 20:14-15

Then Abimelech took sheep, oxen, and male and female servants, and gave [them] to Abraham; and he restored Sarah his wife to him. And Abimelech said, "See, my land [is] before you; dwell where it pleases you."

(Abraham moves and has Isaac)

Genesis 21:22-23

And it came to pass at that time that Abimelech and Phichol, the commander of his army, spoke to Abraham, saying, "Elohim [is] with you in all that you do. Now therefore, swear to me by Elohim that you will not deal falsely with me, with my offspring, or with my posterity; but that according to the kindness that I have done to you, you will do to me and to the land in which you have dwelt."

Genesis 21:25

Then Abraham rebuked Abimelech because of a well of water which Abimelech's servants had seized.

Genesis 21:30-31

And he said, "You will take [these] seven ewe lambs from my hand, that they may be my witness that I have dug this well."

Therefore **he called that place Beersheba,** because **the two of them swore an oath there.**

Genesis 25:19

This [is] the genealogy of Isaac, **Abraham's son**. Abraham begot Isaac.

Genesis 26:1-2

There was a famine in the land, besides the first famine that was in the days of Abraham.

And Isaac went to Abimelech king of the Philistines, in Gerar. Then YHVH appeared to him and said: "Do not go down to Egypt; **live in the land of which I shall tell you.**"

(Sons already born-Birthright sold)

Genesis 26:3-4

"Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform the oath which I swore to Abraham your father. And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed;"

Genesis 26:5

“Because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws.”

(Hint, hint...)

Genesis 26:6-7

So Isaac dwelt in **Gerar**. And the men of the place asked about his wife. And he said, "**She [is] my sister**"; for he was afraid to say, "She is my wife," because he thought, "lest the men of the place kill me for Rebekah, because she [is] beautiful to behold."

(Lesson for sons-deception? He is seen)

Genesis 26:12-14

Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year a hundredfold; and **YHVH** **blessed him**.

The man began to prosper, and continued prospering until he became very prosperous; for he had possessions of flocks and possessions of herds and a great number of servants. So the Philistines envied him.

Genesis 26:15

Now the Philistines had **stopped up all the wells which his father's servants had dug in the days of Abraham his father,** and they had filled them with earth.

Genesis 26:18

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Genesis 26:21

Then they dug another well, and they quarreled over that [one] also. So he called its name Sitnah.

Genesis 26:22

And he moved from there and dug another well, and they did not quarrel over it. So he called its name Rehoboth, because he said, **"For now YHVH has made room for us, and we shall be fruitful in the land."**

Genesis 26:23-24

Then he went up from there to Beersheba (oath). And YHVH appeared to him the same night and said, "I [am] the Elohim of your father Abraham; do not fear, for I [am] with you. I will bless you and multiply your descendants for My servant Abraham's sake."

Genesis 13:17

“Arise, walk in the land
through its length and its
width, for I give it to you.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 5:33

"You shall walk in all the ways which YHVH your Elohim has commanded you, that you may live and [that it may be] well with you, and [that] you may prolong [your] days in the land which you shall possess."

Isaiah (Isaias) 30:20

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:5

"They have corrupted themselves; they are not His children, because of their blemish: a perverse and crooked generation."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:7

"Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations. Ask your father, and he will show you; your elders (old, ancient), and they will tell you..."

(Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:9
“For YHWH's portion [is] His people; Jacob [is]
the place of His inheritance.”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:10

"He found him in a desert land and in the wasteland, a howling wilderness; He encircled him, He instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye."

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 6:16

This is what YHVH says: "Stop at the crossroads and look around. Ask for the old, godly way, and walk in it. Travel its path, and you will find rest for your souls. But you reply, 'No, that's not the road we want!'"

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 31:33

"But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel on that day," says YHVH. **"I will put my instructions deep within them, and I will write them on their hearts. I will be their Elohim, and they will be my people."**

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 31:34
