- And it came to pass **at the end of** two full years, that Pharaoh dreamed: and, behold, he stood by the river.

Yah Spoke to Pharaoh (Gen 41)

- 15 And Pharaoh said to Yosēph, “I have dreamed a dream, and there is no one to interpret it. Now I myself have heard it said of you that you understand a dream, to interpret it.”
- 16 And Yosēph answered Pharaoh, saying, “It is not in me, let Elohim answer Pharaoh with peace.”
- (17-24 the dream)
- 25 And Yosēph said to Pharaoh, “The dream of Pharaoh is one. Elohim has shown Pharaoh what He is about to do.

Yah spoke to Pharaoh (Gen 41)

- (26-27 the interpretation)
- 28 “This is the word which I spoke to Pharaoh:
Elohim has shown Pharaoh what He is about to do.
- 32 “And the dream was repeated to Pharaoh *twice*
because the word is established by Elohim, and
Elohim is hastening to do it.

- Yah spoke to Pharaoh.

YAH also spoke to...

- Laban

- Nebudchadnezzar

Where is “The Line”

- Between believers, and pagans?

Did Yeshua draw a line?

- Follow me, abide in me...
- [Mat 19:16-17] 16 And someone came to Him and said, "Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may obtain eternal life?" 17 And He said to him, "Why are you asking Me about what is good? There is [only] One who is good; but if you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments."

Did Yeshua draw a line?

- [Mat 8:5-7] 5 And when Yeshua entered Capernaum, a **centurion** came to Him, imploring Him, 6 and saying, "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, fearfully tormented." 7 Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him."
- [Mat 8:11-12] 11 "I say to you that **many will come from east and west**, and recline [at the table] with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven; 12 but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Did Yeshua draw a line?

- [Jhn 10:16] 16 "I have **other sheep**, which are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will hear My voice; and they will become one flock [with] one shepherd.
- [Mat 28:18-20] 18 And Yeshua came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of **all the nations...**

Did Yeshua draw a line?

- YES.
- [Mat 25:33-34] 33 and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left. 34 "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.
- [Mat 25:41] 41 "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels;
- Yes. At the judgment.

All are EQUAL, for now...

- [Mat 13:30] 30 'Allow both to grow together until the harvest; and in the time of the harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather up the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them up; but gather the wheat into my barn."'"
- [Mat 5:45] 45 ...He causes His sun to rise on [the] evil and [the] good, and sends rain on [the] righteous and [the] unrighteous.

Psalm 73

- [Psa 73:2-3, 5, 8-9, 11-14, 16-19, 27 NASB] 2 But as for me, my feet came close to stumbling, My steps had almost slipped. 3 For I was envious of the arrogant As I saw the prosperity of the wicked. ... 5 They are not in trouble as other men, Nor are they plagued like mankind. ... 8 They mock and wickedly speak of oppression; They speak from on high. 9 They have set their mouth against the heavens, And their tongue parades through the earth. ... 11 They say, "How does God know? And is there knowledge with the Most High?" ...

Psalm 73


- 12 Behold, these are the wicked; And always at ease, they have increased in wealth. 13 Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure And washed my hands in innocence; 14 For I have been stricken all day long And chastened every morning. ... 16 When I pondered to understand this, It was troublesome in my sight 17 Until I came into the sanctuary of God; Then I perceived their end. 18 Surely You set them in slippery places; You cast them down to destruction. 19 How they are destroyed in a moment! They are utterly swept away by sudden terrors! ... 27 For, behold, those who are far from You will perish; You have destroyed all those who are unfaithful to You.

Revelation 20

- [Rev 20:11-13] 11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.

- [Ecc 12:13-14] 13 The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God and keep His commandments, because **this applies to every person.** 14 For God will bring every act to judgment, everything which is hidden, whether it is good or evil.
