# Psalm (Salmos) 119:18

**Open my eyes,** that I may see Wondrous  
things from Your Torah.

## Genesis 42:8

So Joseph recognized his brothers, **but they did not recognize him.**

# Romans (Romanos) 11:7-8

What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded.

Just as it is written: "Elohim has given them a spirit of stupor, **Eyes that they should not see** and ears that they should not hear, to this very day." (Example?)

## Numbers (Numeros) 12:6

Then He said, "Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, YHVH, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream."

## Genesis 37:3

Now Israel **loved** Joseph more than all his children, because he [was] the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of [many] colors.

## Genesis 37:5-6

Now Joseph had a dream, and he told [it] to his brothers; and **they hated him even more.** So he said to them, "Please hear this dream which I have dreamed..."



## Genesis 37:8

And his brothers said to him, "Shall you indeed reign over us? Or shall you indeed have dominion over us?" So they hated him even more for his dreams and for his words.

## Genesis 37:9

Then **he dreamed still another dream and told it to his brothers,** and said, "Look, I have dreamed another dream. And this time, the sun, the moon, and the eleven stars bowed down to me."

# Genesis 37:10-11

So he told [it] to his father and his brothers; and his father rebuked him and said to him, "What [is] this dream that you have dreamed? Shall your mother and I and your brothers indeed come to bow down to the earth before you?"

And **his brothers envied him, but his father kept the matter [in mind].**

(Why? Why do the brothers not see?)

## John (Juan) 7:3-5

**His brothers** therefore said to him, "Depart from here and go into Judea, that your disciples also may see the works that you are doing.

For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world."

**For even his brothers did not believe in him.**

## John (Juan) 6:41-42

The Jews then complained about him,  
because he said, "I am the bread which came  
down from heaven."

And they said, "Is not this Yeshua, **the son of Joseph**, whose father and mother we know?

How is it then that he says, 'I have come  
down from heaven'?" (Born where?)

## Matthew (Mateo) 13:54-55

When he had come to his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and [these] mighty works?"

Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary? And his brothers James, Joseph, Simon, and Judas?"

## Matthew (Mateo) 13:57

So they were offended at him. But Yeshua said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house."

## Genesis 37:13-14

And Israel said to Joseph, "Are not your brothers feeding [the flock] in Shechem? **Come, I will send you to them.**" So he said to him, "Here I am." Then he said to him, **"Please go and see if it is well with your brothers and well with the flocks, and bring back word to me."** So he sent him out of the Valley of Hebron, and he went to Shechem.



## John (Juan) 8:29

And He who sent me is with me. The Father has not left me alone, for I always do those things that please Him.

## Genesis 37:18-20

Now when they saw him afar off, even before he came near them, **they conspired against him to kill him.** Then they said to one another, "Look, this dreamer is coming!

Come therefore, let us now kill him and cast him into some pit; and we shall say, 'Some wild beast has devoured him.' **We shall see what will become of his dreams!"**

## John (Juan) 11:49-50

And one of them, Caiaphas, being high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all, nor do you consider that it is expedient for us **that one man should die for the people**, and not that the whole nation should perish."

## John (Juan) 11:51-53

Now this he did not say on his own authority; but being high priest that year he prophesied that Yeshua would die for the nation, and not for that nation only, but also that he would gather together in one the children of Elohim who were scattered abroad.

**Then, from that day on, they plotted to put him to death.**

# Genesis 37:25

And **they sat down to eat a meal.** Then  
they lifted their eyes and looked, and **there**  
**was a company of Ishmaelites,** coming from  
Gilead with their camels, bearing spices,  
balm, and myrrh, on their way to carry  
[them] down to Egypt.  
(What was eaten after Messiah died? Clue?)

## Genesis 37:31

So they took Joseph's tunic, **killed a kid of the goats, and dipped the tunic in the blood.**  
(Lamb can be taken from sheep or goats)

## Genesis 37:26-27

So Judah said to his brothers, "What profit [is there] if we kill our brother and conceal his blood? **"Come and let us sell him** to the Ishmaelites, and let not our hand be upon him, for he [is] our brother [and] our flesh."

And his brothers listened.

(Judas and ??)

## John (Juan) 18:30-31

They answered and said to him, "If he were not an evildoer, **we would not have delivered him up to you.**"

Then Pilate said to them, "You take him and judge him according to your law." Therefore the Jews said to him, **"It is not lawful for us to put anyone to death..."**



## In prison- On the tree

- 2 people have dreams
- 1 judged & the other spared and lifted up
- 2 people hung with him
- 1 judged & the other spared and lifted up

## Genesis 41:14

Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him quickly out of the dungeon; and **he shaved, changed his clothing, and came to Pharaoh.**

## Genesis 41:16

So Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, "It is not in me; Elohim will give Pharaoh an answer of peace."

(Not my words/works)

## John (Juan) 14:10

"Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? **The words that I speak to you I do not speak on my own authority; but the Father who dwells in me does the works."**

## Genesis 41:38-39

And Pharaoh said to his servants, "Can we find [such a one] as this, a man in whom [is] the Spirit of Elohim?"

Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Inasmuch as Elohim has shown you all this, [there is] no one as discerning and wise as you."

# Genesis 41:37

So the advice **was good in the eyes** of Pharaoh and **in the eyes** of all his servants.

## Matthew (Mateo) 27:54

So when the centurion and those with him, who were guarding Yeshua, saw the earthquake and the things that had happened, they feared greatly, saying, "Truly this was the Son of Elohim!"

## Genesis 41:42

Then Pharaoh took his signet ring off his hand and put it on Joseph's hand; and **he clothed him in garments of fine linen and put a gold chain around his neck.**



## Genesis 41:45

And **Pharaoh called Joseph's name Zaphnath-Paaneah.** And he gave him as a wife Asenath, the daughter of Poti-Pherah priest of On. So Joseph went out over [all] the land of Egypt.

## Luke (Lucas) 1:31

"And behold, you will conceive in your womb  
and bring forth a son, and shall call his name  
JESUS."

## Other Changes

- Born in December to Mary and Joseph
- Not Jewish- Greek or Roman

## John (Juan) 9:39-40

And Yeshua said, "For judgment I have come into this world, **that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind.**"

Then [some] of the Pharisees who were with him heard these words, and said to him, "Are we blind also?"

## John (Juan) 9:41

Yeshua said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no sin; but now you say, 'We see.' Therefore your sin remains."

## Matthew (Mateo) 23:39

“I say to you, **you shall see me no more till you say, ‘Blessed [is] He who comes in the name of YHVH.’”**

(Accept Yah’s plan and authority- Bow down)

## Genesis 45:1, 3

Then Joseph could not restrain himself before all those who stood by him, and he cried out, "Make everyone go out from me!" So no one stood with him while **Joseph made himself known to his brothers.** Then Joseph said to his brothers, "I [am] Joseph; does my father still live?" **But his brothers could not answer him, for they were dismayed in his presence.**

# Zechariah (Zacharias) 12:10

"And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; **then they will look on Me whom they pierced.** Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for [his] only [son], and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn."



## Genesis 50:19-20

Joseph said to them, "Do not be afraid, for  
[am] I in the place of Elohim?

But as for you, you meant evil against me;  
[but] Elohim meant it for good, in order to  
bring it about as [it is] this day, to save many  
people alive."

## Leviticus (Levitico) 26:40-41

“**But if they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers,** with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked contrary to Me, and [that] I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt—”

## Leviticus (Levitico) 26:42

“Then I will remember My covenant with Jacob, and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham I will remember; I will remember the land.”

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
