Psalm (Salmos) 119:18

Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous
things from **Your Torah.**

Romans (Romanos) 11:1-3

I ask then: Did Elohim reject his people? By no means! I am an Israelite myself, a descendant of Abraham, from the tribe of Benjamin. **Elohim did not reject his people, whom he foreknew.** Don't you know what Scripture says in the passage about Elijah--how he appealed to Elohim against Israel: **“YHVH, they have killed your prophets and torn down your altars; I am the only one left, and they are trying to kill me”?**

Romans (Romanos) 11:7-8

What then? What the people of Israel sought so earnestly they did not obtain. The elect among them did, but the others were hardened, as it is written: "Elohim gave them a spirit of stupor, **eyes that could not see and ears that could not hear, to this very day.**"

Why didn't the Jewish leaders believe?

- **Did Elohim reject His people?**
- **Killed Your prophets, I am the only one left and they are plotting to kill me**
- **Some believed and some were hardened-BLINDED**
- **Why could they not see?**

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 18:18-19

I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and **will put My words in His mouth,** and **He shall speak to them all that I command Him.**

And it shall be [that] whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name (authority), **I will require [it] of him.**

John (Juan) 14:10-11

"Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? **The words that I speak to you I do not speak on my own [authority]; but the Father who dwells in me does the works.**

Believe me that I [am] in the Father and the Father in me, or else believe me for the sake of the works themselves."

Matthew (Mateo) 12:2

But some Pharisees saw them do it and
protested, "Look, your disciples are breaking
the law by harvesting grain on the Shabbat."

Matthew (Mateo) 12:7

“But you would not have condemned my innocent disciples if you knew the meaning of this Scripture: ‘I want you to show mercy, not offer sacrifices.’”

(Paralytic-Tax collector vs. Pharisee)

Matthew (Mateo) 12:9-10

Then Yeshua went over to their synagogue, where he noticed a man with a deformed hand. The Pharisees asked Yeshua, "**Does the law permit a person to work by healing on the Shabbat?**" (They were hoping he would say yes, so they could bring charges against him.)

Matthew (Mateo) 12:11-12

And he answered, "If you had a sheep that fell into a well (ditch) on the Shabbat, wouldn't you work to pull it out? Of course you would.

And how much more valuable is a person than a sheep! **Yes, the law permits a person to do good on the Shabbat."**

Exodus (Exodo) 23:4-5

"If you meet your enemy's ox or his donkey going astray, you shall surely bring it back to him again. If you see the donkey of one who hates you lying under its burden, and you would refrain from helping it, you shall surely help him with it."

Exodus (Exodo) 23:6-7

"You shall not pervert the judgment of your poor in his dispute. **Keep yourself far from a false matter; do not kill the innocent and righteous.** For I will not justify the wicked."

Matthew (Mateo) 12:13-14

Then he said to the man, "Hold out your hand." So the man held out his hand, and it was restored, just like the other one!

Then **the Pharisees called a meeting to plot how to kill Yeshua.**

(Another Sign on Shabbat?)

John (Juan) 5:5-6

One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-eight years. When Yeshua saw him and knew he had been ill for a long time, he asked him, **"Would you like to get well?"**

John (Juan) 5:8-10

Yeshua told him, "**Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!**" Instantly, the man was healed! He rolled up his sleeping mat and began walking! **But this miracle happened on the Shabbat**, so the Jewish leaders objected. They said to the man who was cured, "You can't work on the Shabbat! The law doesn't allow you to carry that sleeping mat!"

John (Juan) 5:11

But he replied, "The man who healed me told me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'"

John (Juan) 5:14-16

But afterward Yeshua found him in the Temple and
told him, "**Now you are well; so stop sinning, or
something even worse may happen to you.**"

Then the man went and told the Jewish leaders
that it was Yeshua who had healed him.

So the Jewish leaders began harassing Yeshua for
breaking the Shabbat rules.

John (Juan) 5:17-18

But Yeshua replied, "My Father is always working, and so am I."

So the Jewish leaders tried all the harder to find a way to kill him. For he not only broke the Shabbat, he called Elohim his Father, thereby making himself equal with Elohim.

John (Juan) 5:19-20

So Yeshua explained, "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him everything he is doing. In fact, the Father will show him how to do even greater works than healing this man. Then you will truly be astonished."

John (Juan) 9:1-2

Now as Yeshua passed by, he saw a man who was blind from birth.

And his disciples asked him, saying, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

John (Juan) 9:3-5

Yeshua answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of Elohim should be revealed in him. I must work the works of Him who sent me while it is day; [the] night is coming when no one can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

John (Juan) 9:6-7

When he had said these things, he spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. And he said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam". So he went and washed, **and came back seeing.**

John (Juan) 9:8-10

Therefore the neighbors and those who previously had seen that he was blind said,

"Is not this he who sat and begged?"

Some said, **"This is he."** Others [said], "He is like him." He said, "I am [he]."

Therefore they said to him, **"How were your eyes opened?"** (Appearance?)

John (Juan) 9:11-13

He answered and said, "**A man called Yeshua made clay and anointed my eyes** and said to me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.'
So I went and washed, and I received sight."

Then they said to him, "**Where is he?**" He said, "I do not know."

They brought him who formerly was blind to the Pharisees. (Why?)

John (Juan) 9:14

Now it was a Shabbat **when Yeshua made the clay and opened his eyes.**

John (Juan) 9:15-16

Then the Pharisees also asked him again how he had received his sight. He said to them, **"He put clay on my eyes, and I washed, and I see."**

Therefore some of the Pharisees said, **"This man is not from Elohim, because he does not keep the Shabbat."** Others said, "How can a man who is a sinner do such signs?" And there was a division among them.

John (Juan) 9:17-18

They said to the blind man again, "What do you say about him because he opened your eyes?" He said, "He is a prophet."

But **the Jews did not believe concerning him,** that he had been blind and received his sight, until they called the parents of him who had received his sight.

John (Juan) 9:19-21

And they asked them, saying, "Is this your son, who you say was born blind? How then does he now see?" His parents answered them and said,

"We know that this is our son, and that he was born blind; **but by what means he now sees we do not know, or who opened his eyes we do not know.** He is of age; ask him. He will speak for himself."

John (Juan) 9:22

His parents said these [things] because they
feared the Jews, for the Jews had agreed
already that if anyone confessed [that] he
[was] Messiah, he would be put out of the
synagogue.

John (Juan) 9:24-25

So they again called the man who was blind, and said to him, "Give Elohim the glory! We know that this man is a sinner."

He answered and said, "Whether he is a sinner or not I do not know. One thing I know: that though I was blind, now I see."

John (Juan) 9:26-28

Then they said to him again, "What did he do to you? How did he open your eyes?"

He answered them, "I told you already, and you did not listen. Why do you want to hear [it] again?

Do you also want to become his disciples?"

Then they reviled him and said, **"You are his disciple, but we are Moses' disciples."**

John (Juan) 9:29-30

"We know that Elohim spoke to Moses; [as for] this [fellow], we do not know where he is from." The man answered and said to them, "Why, **this is a marvelous thing, that you do not know where he is from; yet he has opened my eyes!"**

John (Juan) 9:31-33

"Now we know that Elohim does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshiper of Elohim and does His will, He hears him. Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind. **If this man were not from Elohim, he could do nothing."**

John (Juan) 9:34

They answered and said to him, "You were completely born in sins, **and are you teaching us?"** And they cast him out.
(Did Yah listen to his prayers?)

John (Juan) 9:35-38

Yeshua heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of Elohim?" He answered and said, "Who is he, Lord, that I may believe in him?" And Yeshua said to him, **"You have both seen him and it is he who is talking with you."** Then he said, **"Lord, I believe!"** And he worshiped him. (Like Moses.)

John (Juan) 9:39

And Yeshua said, "For judgment I have come into this world, **that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind.**"

John (Juan) 9:40-41

Then [some] of the Pharisees who were with him heard these words, and said to him, "Are we blind also?"

Yeshua said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no sin; **but now you say, 'We see.'** **Therefore your sin remains."**

Isaiah (Isaias) 29:9-10

Pause and wonder! **Blind yourselves and be blind!** They are drunk, but not with wine; they stagger, but not with intoxicating drink. For YHVH has poured out on you the spirit of deep sleep, and has closed your eyes, namely, the prophets; and He has covered your heads, [namely], the seers.

Isaiah (Isaias) 29:11-12

The whole vision has become to you like the words of a book that is **sealed**, which [men] deliver to one who is literate, saying, "Read this, please."

And he says, **"I cannot, for it [is] sealed."**

Then the book is delivered to one who is illiterate, saying, "Read this, please." And he says, **"I am not literate."** (Secret/ hidden things? Sealed?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 29:13

Therefore YHVH said: "Inasmuch as these people draw near with their mouths and honor Me with their lips, but have removed their hearts far from Me, **and their fear toward Me is taught by the commandment of men...**" (Your traditions keep you from Elohim)

Isaiah (Isaias) 29:14

“Therefore, behold, **I will again do a marvelous work among this people, a marvelous work and a wonder;** For the wisdom of their wise [men] shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent [men] shall be **hidden.**”

(You shall not add to or take from
Dt. 4:2,12:32)
