## Isaiah (Isaias) 60:1-3

**Arise, shine;** for your light has come! And the glory of YHVH is risen upon you.

For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, **and deep darkness the people;** but YHVH will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you.

**The Nations (Gentiles) shall come to your light,**  
And kings to the brightness of your rising.

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:1-4

"Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom.

Now five of them were wise, and five [were] foolish. Those who [were] foolish took their lamps and **took no oil with them,** but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps."

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:5-7

"But while the bridegroom was delayed, they  
all slumbered and slept.

And at midnight a cry was [heard]: 'Behold, the  
bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!'

Then all those virgins arose and **trimmed their  
lamps."**

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:8

"And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us [some] of your oil, for our lamps are going out.'"

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:9-10

"But the wise answered, saying, '[No], lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and **those who were ready went in with him** to the wedding; and the door was shut."

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:13

"Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which **the Son of Man is coming.**"

## Matthew (Mateo) 25:30

“And cast the unprofitable servant **into the outer darkness.** There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.”



## Matthew (Mateo) 25:8

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:4-5

"But you who held fast to YHVH your Elohim [are] alive today, every one of you. Surely I have taught you statutes and judgments, just as YHVH my Elohim commanded me, **that you should act according [to them]** in the land which you go to possess."

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:6

"Therefore be careful to observe [them]; for this [is] your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes, and say, 'Surely this great nation [is] a wise and understanding people.'"

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:7-8

"For what great nation [is there] that **has Elohim [so] near to it, as YHVH our Elohim [is] to us,** for whatever [reason] we may call upon Him?

And what great nation [is there] **that has [such] statutes and righteous judgments as are in all this law** which I set before you this day?"

## Leviticus (Levitico) 24:1-3

Then YHVH spoke to Moses, saying:

**"Command the children of Israel that they bring to you pure oil of pressed olives for the light, to make the lamps burn continually.**

Outside the veil of the Testimony, in the tabernacle of meeting, Aaron shall be in charge of it **from evening until morning before YHVH continually;** [it shall be] a statute forever in your generations."



## Exodus (Exodo) 30:6-8

"And you shall put it before the veil that [is] before the ark of the Testimony, before the mercy seat that [is] over the Testimony, **where I will meet with you.** **Aaron shall burn on it sweet incense every morning; when he tends the lamps,** he shall burn incense on it. And **when Aaron lights the lamps at twilight,** he shall burn incense on it, a perpetual incense before YHVH throughout your generations."

## Matthew (Mateo) 5:14-16

"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and **it gives light to all [who are] in the house.** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." (Guess what is next?)

## Matthew (Mateo) 5:17

"Do not think that I came to destroy **the Law or the Prophets**. I did not come to destroy but  
to fulfill."

(What good works will be seen?)

# Genesis 1:3-5

Then Elohim said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

And Elohim saw the light, that [it was] good; and Elohim divided the light from the darkness.

**Elohim called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night.** So the evening and the morning were the first day.

## John (Juan) 9:4-5

"I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; [the] **night is coming when no one can work.**

As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

## John (Juan) 11:9-10

Yeshua answered, "Are there not twelve hours in the day? If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world.

But **if one walks in the night, he stumbles, because the light is not in him."**

## Exodus (Exodo) 12:12-13

“For I will pass through the land of Egypt **on that night**, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the elohims of Egypt I will execute judgment: I [am] YHVH.

Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you [are]. And when I see the blood, I **will pass over you**; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy [you] when I strike the land of Egypt.”



## Exodus (Exodo) 12:22-23

“And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip [it] in the blood that [is] in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that [is] in the basin. **And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning.** For YHVH will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, YHVH will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike [you].”

## Genesis 19:1

Now the two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw [them], he rose to meet them, and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground.

## Exodus (Exodo) 12:22-23

“And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip [it] in the blood that [is] in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that [is] in the basin. **And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning.** For YHVH will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, YHVH will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike [you].”

## Amos 5:18,20

“Woe to you who **desire the day of YHVH!** For what good [is] the day of YHVH to you? It will be darkness, and not light.

**Is not the day of YHVH darkness, and not light?**

**Is it not very dark, with no brightness in it?”**

## Genesis 32:21-23

## Genesis 32:27-28

So He said to him, "What [is] your name?" He said, "Jacob."

And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with Elohim and with men, and have prevailed."



## Genesis 32:30

So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel:  
"For I have seen Elohim face to face, **and my  
life is preserved.**"

## Revelation (Apocalipsis) 22:3-5

“And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of Elohim and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. They shall see His face, and His name [shall be] on their foreheads.

**There shall be no night there:** they need no lamp nor light of the sun, for **YHVH Elohim gives them light**. And they shall reign forever and ever.”
