Light 3

Matthew (Mateo) 5:14-16

"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all [who are] in the house. **Let your light so shine before men,** that they may **see your good works** and glorify your Father in heaven."
(Fire inside and outside?)

Exodus (Exodo) 29:38-39

"Now this is what you shall offer on the altar:
two lambs of the first year, day by day
continually.

One lamb you shall offer in the **morning,** and
the **other lamb you shall offer at **twilight.****
(Foundation of offerings, relationship)

Exodus (Exodo) 29:42-43

"This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations [at] the door of the tabernacle of meeting before YHVH, where

I will meet you to speak with you.

And **there I will meet with the children of Israel,** and [the tabernacle-they] shall be sanctified by My glory." (Another fire? How often?)

Leviticus (Levitico) 6:9

"Command Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This [is] the law of the burnt offering: **The burnt offering shall be on the hearth upon the altar all night until morning, and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it.**

And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen trousers he shall put on his body, and **take up the ashes of the burnt offering which the fire has consumed on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar.'"**

Leviticus (Levitico) 6:11-13

“Then he shall take off his garments, put on other garments, and carry the ashes outside the camp to a clean place. And the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not be put out. **And the priest shall burn wood on it every morning,** and lay the burnt offering in order on it; and he shall burn on it the fat of the peace offerings. **A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out.”**

Matthew (Mateo) 5:14-16

Leviticus (Levitico) 2:13

“And every offering of your grain offering you shall **season with salt**; you shall not allow the **salt of the covenant** of your Elohim to be lacking from your grain offering. **With all your offerings you shall offer salt.**”

Salt loses flavor?

- **His Will**
- **Given from the heart, out of love**
- **Humbly serve**
- **Serve/obey for others not self**

Leviticus (Levitico) 1:1-2

Now YHVH called to Moses, and spoke to him from the tabernacle of meeting, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: '**When any one of you brings an offering to YHVH**, you shall bring your offering of the livestock--of the herd and of the flock.'"

Leviticus (Levitico) 1:3-4

“If his offering is a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish; **he shall offer it of his own free will at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before YHVH.**

Then he shall put his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him.”

Exodus (Exodo) 25:2

"Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering. From everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering."
(Humbly)

Exodus (Exodo) 30:20-21

"When they go into the tabernacle of meeting,
or when they come near the altar to minister,
to burn an offering made by fire to YHVH, they
shall wash with water, lest they die.

So they shall wash their hands and their feet,
lest they die. And it shall be a statute forever
to them--to him and his descendants
throughout their generations."

Isaiah (Isaias) 57:15

For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name [is] Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him [who] has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones."

Isaiah (Isaias) 58:8

"Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of YHWH shall be your rear guard."

(Others)

Numbers (Numeros) 16:46,48

So Moses said to Aaron, "Take a censer and put fire in it from the altar, put incense [on it], and take it quickly to the congregation and **make atonement for them**; for wrath has gone out from YHVH. The plague has begun." And he stood between the dead and the living; so the plague was stopped.

Exodus (Exodo) 30:6-8

"And you shall put it before the veil that [is] before the ark of the Testimony, before the mercy seat that [is] over the Testimony, **where I will meet with you.** **Aaron shall burn on it sweet incense every morning; when he tends the lamps,** he shall burn incense on it. And **when Aaron lights the lamps at twilight, he shall burn incense on it, a perpetual incense before YHVH throughout your generations."**

Matthew (Mateo) 5:13

"You are the salt of the earth; **but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned?** It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men."

1 Samuel 15:1, 3

Samuel also said to Saul, "YHVH sent me to anoint you king over His people, over Israel. Now therefore, **heed the voice of the words of YHVH.**

'Now go and attack Amalek, and **utterly destroy all that they have, and do not spare them.** But kill both man and woman, infant and nursing child, ox and sheep, camel and donkey.'"

1 Samuel 15:9

But Saul and the people spared Agag and the best of the sheep, the oxen, the fatlings, the lambs, and all [that was] good, and were unwilling to utterly destroy them. But everything despised and worthless, that they utterly destroyed.
(Whose will)

1 Samuel 15:12

So when Samuel rose early in the morning to meet Saul, it was told Samuel, saying, "Saul went to Carmel, and indeed, **he set up a monument for himself**; and he has gone on around, passed by, and gone down to Gilgal."
(Humble?)

1 Samuel 15:13-14

Then Samuel went to Saul, and Saul said to him, "Blessed are you of YHVH! I have performed the commandment of YHVH."

But Samuel said, "What then [is] this bleating of the sheep in my ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?"

1 Samuel 15:15

And Saul said, "They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and the oxen, to sacrifice to YHVH your Elohim; and the rest we have utterly destroyed."

1 Samuel 15:17-18

So Samuel said, "**When you [were] little in your own eyes,** were you not head of the tribes of Israel? And did not YHVH anoint you king over Israel? **Now YHVH sent you on a mission, and said, 'Go, and utterly destroy the sinners, the Amalekites, and fight against them until they are consumed.'**"

1 Samuel 15:21-22

"But the people took of the plunder, sheep and oxen, the best of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice to YHVH your Elohim in Gilgal." So Samuel said:

"Has YHVH as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of YHVH? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed than the fat of rams." (Why doing it?)

1 Samuel 15:30-31

Then he said, "I have sinned; yet **honor me now**, please, before the elders of my people and before Israel, and return with me, **that I may worship YHVH your Elohim.**"

So Samuel turned back after Saul, and Saul worshiped YHVH. (How?)

Leviticus (Levitico) 6:11-13

“Then he shall take off his garments, put on other garments, and carry the ashes outside the camp to a clean place. And the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not be put out. **And the priest shall burn wood on it every morning**, and lay the burnt offering in order on it; and he shall burn on it the fat of the peace offerings. **A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out.**”

Isaiah (Isaias) 60:1-3

Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the
glory of YHVH is risen upon you.

For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth,
and deep darkness the people; **but YHVH will**
arise over you, and **His glory will be seen upon**
you.

The Nations (Gentiles) shall come to your light,
And kings to the brightness of your rising.
