## Matthew (Mateo) 12:38-39

Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from you."

But he answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and **no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah.**"

## Matthew (Mateo) 7:1-2

"Judge not, that you be not judged.

For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; **and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you."**

(Judgment based on what?)

## Matthew (Mateo) 7:12

"Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, **for this is the Law and the Prophets.**"

## Matthew (Mateo) 5:43-44

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.'

But I say to you, **love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you..."**

(Speck & Log- Why love enemy?)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:4-5

"But you who held fast to YHVH your Elohim [are] alive today, every one of you. Surely I have taught you statutes and judgments, just as YHVH my Elohim commanded me, **that you should act according [to them]** in the land which you go to possess."

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:6

"Therefore be careful to observe [them]; for this [is] your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes, and say, 'Surely this great nation [is] a wise and understanding people.'"  
(What do they see?)

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 4:7-8

"For what great nation [is there] that **has Elohim [so] near to it, as YHVH our Elohim [is] to us,** for whatever [reason] we may call upon Him?

And what great nation [is there] **that has [such] statutes and righteous judgments as are in all this law** which I set before you this day?"

## Isaiah (Isaias) 42:6-7

"I, YHVH, have called You in righteousness, and will hold Your hand; I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, as a light to the Nations (Gentiles),  
To open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house."

## Isaiah (Isaias) 60:1-3

**Arise, shine;** for your light has come! And the glory of YHVH is risen upon you.

For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, **and deep darkness the people;** but YHVH will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you.

**The Nations (Gentiles) shall come to your light,**  
And kings to the brightness of your rising.

## Jonah (Jonas) 1:1-2

Now the word of YHVH came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying,

**"Arise,** go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me."

(Like Sodom & Gomorrah? Nineveh?)

## 2 Kings (Reyes) 18:11-12

Then the king of Assyria carried Israel away captive to Assyria, and put them in Halah and by the Habor, the River of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes, **because they did not obey the voice of YHVH their Elohim, but transgressed His covenant *and* all that Moses the servant of YHVH had commanded; *and they would neither hear nor do them...***

# Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:49-50

“YHVH will bring a nation against you from afar, from the end of the earth, *as swift* as the eagle flies, a nation whose language you will not understand, a nation of fierce countenance, **which does not respect the elderly nor show favor to the young.**”

(Serve our enemies, scatter you among the nations, children given to another people)

## 2 Kings (Reyes) 18:13

And in the fourteenth year of King Hezekiah,  
**Sennacherib king of Assyria** came up against all  
the fortified cities of Judah and took them.

## 2 Kings (Reyes) 19:10-11

“Thus you shall speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying: ‘Do not let your Elohim in whom you trust deceive you, saying, “Jerusalem shall not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria.” **Look! You have heard what the kings of Assyria have done to all lands by utterly destroying them;** and shall you be delivered?’”

## 2 Kings (Reyes) 19:35-35

“And it came to pass on a certain night that the angel of YHVH went out, and killed in the camp of the Assyrians one hundred and eighty-five thousand; and when *people* arose early in the morning, there were the corpses—all dead. **So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed and went away, returned *home*, and remained at Nineveh.”**

## Jonah (Jonas) 1:3

But Jonah arose to flee to **Tarshish** from the presence of YHVH. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and **went down into it**, to go with them to **Tarshish** from the presence of YHVH.

## Jonah (Jonas) 1:17

Now YHVH had prepared a great fish to swallow Jonah. **And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.**

## Jonah (Jonas) 3:4-5

And Jonah began to enter the city on the first day's walk. Then he cried out and said, "Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!"

**So the people of Nineveh believed Elohim,**  
proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from  
the greatest to the least of them.

(Like Abraham)

## Jonah (Jonas) 3:10-4:1

Then Elohim saw their works, **that they turned from their evil way;** and Elohim relented from the disaster that He had said He would bring upon them, and He did not do it. **But it displeased Jonah exceedingly,** and he became angry.

## Jonah (Jonas) 4:2-3

So he prayed to YHVH, and said, "Ah, YHVH, was not this what I said when I was still in my country?"

Therefore **I fled previously to Tarshish**; for I know that You [are] a gracious and merciful Elohim, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm.

Therefore now, O YHVH, please take my life from me, for [it is] better for me to die than to live!"

## Jonah (Jonas) 4:10-11

But YHVH said, "You have had pity on the plant for which you have not labored, nor made it grow, which came up in a night and perished in a night. **And should I not pity Nineveh,** that great city, in which are more than one hundred and twenty thousand persons who cannot discern between their right hand and their left--and much livestock?"

(Apply to Messiah?)

## Luke (Lucas) 2:30-32

“For my eyes have seen Your salvation  
which You have prepared before the face of all  
peoples,

A light to [bring] revelation to the Nations  
(Gentiles), and the glory of Your people Israel.”

## Matthew (Mateo) 16:16-17

Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living Elohim."

Yeshua answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, **Simon Bar-Jonah**, for flesh and blood has not revealed [this] to you, but My Father who is in heaven." (Foundation of congregation)

## Matthew (Mateo) 28:19-20

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, mikvahing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." (How?)

## Acts (Hechos) 10:1-2

There was a certain man in Caesarea called **Cornelius**, a centurion of what was called the Italian Regiment,  
**a devout [man] and one who feared Elohim**  
with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to **Elohim** always.

## Acts (Hechos) 10:4-5

And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, YHVH?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before Elohim.

Now send men to **Joppa**, and **send for Simon whose surname is Peter.**" (Joppa?)

## Jonah (Jonas) 1:3

But Jonah arose to flee to **Tarshish** from the presence of YHVH. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and **went down into it**, to go with them to **Tarshish** from the presence of YHVH.

## Acts (Hechos) 10:28

Then he said to them, "You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But Elohim has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean."

## Acts (Hechos) 10:33-35

"So I sent to you immediately, and you have done well to come. Now therefore, we are all present before Elohim, to hear all the things commanded you by Elohim." Then Peter opened [his] mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that Elohim shows no partiality.

But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him."

## Galatians (Galatas) 2:11-12

“Now when Peter had come to Antioch, I withstood him to his face, because he was to be blamed;

for before certain men came from James, he would eat with the Gentiles; **but when they came, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing those who were of the circumcision.”**

## Acts (Hechos) 9:11

So YHVH [said] to him, "**Arise** and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for [one] called **Saul of Tarsus**, for behold, he is praying."

## Acts (Hechos) 9:15

But YHVH said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine **to bear My name before Nations (Gentiles)**, kings, and **the children of Israel.**"

(Abraham-kings will come from him- father of many nations)

## Genesis 17:4-6

“As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you,  
and **you shall be a father of many  
nations.** No longer shall your name be called  
Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I  
have made you a father of many nations. I will  
make you exceedingly fruitful; and **I will make  
nations of you, and kings shall come from  
you.”**

## Acts (Hechos) 9:11

So YHVH [said] to him, "**Arise** and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for [one] called **Saul of Tarsus**, for behold, he is praying."

Josephus ("Ant." i. 6, § 1),
