Luke (Lucas) 24:30-31

"O you of little faith, why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread? **Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up?"**

Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, and you shall eat the herb of the field."


Genesis 3:19
