Exodus (Exodo) 6:6

“Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I [am] YHVH; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.”

Exodus (Exodo) 6:7

“I will take you as My people, and I will be your Elohim. Then you shall know that I [am] YHVH your Elohim who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.”

Genesis 2:16-17

YHVH Elohim commanded the man, saying,
"From any tree of the garden you may eat
freely;
but from the tree of the knowledge of good
and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that
you eat from it you will surely die."

Genesis 3:5

"For Elohim knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like Elohim, knowing good and evil."

Genesis 3:18-19

“Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, And you shall eat the herb of the field. In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; for dust you [are], and to dust you shall return.”

Genesis 3:21

Also for Adam and his wife YHVH Elohim made
tunics of skin, and clothed them.

Genesis 3:22-23

Then YHVH Elohim said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil.

And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, **and eat, and live forever**--

therefore YHVH Elohim sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

Genesis 3:24

So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way,
to guard the way to the tree of life.


Isaiah (Isaias) 28:15

Genesis 4:7

If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, **sin lies at the door.** And its desire [is] for you, **but you should rule over it.**

John (Juan) 8:34-36

Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.**

And a slave does not abide in the house forever, [but] a son abides forever.

Therefore **if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed."**

Matthew (Mateo) 13:38-39

"The field is the world, **the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom**, but the tares are the sons of the wicked [one].

The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels."

Genesis 15:1

After these things the word of YHVH came to Abram in a vision, saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I [am] your shield, your exceedingly great reward."

Genesis 15:5-6

Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him,

"So shall your descendants be."

And he believed in YHVH, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

Genesis 15:7-8

Then He said to him, "I [am] YHVH, **who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it.**"

And he said, "Lord Elohim, how shall I know that I will inherit it?"

Genesis 15:12

Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; **and behold, horror [and] great darkness fell upon him.**

(sleep, darkness)

Genesis 15:13-14

Then He said to Abram: "Know **certainly** that your descendants will be strangers in a land [that is] not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; **afterward they shall come out with great possessions."** (Restoration!!)

Genesis 15:15

"Now as for you, **you shall go to your fathers in peace**; you shall be buried at a good old age."
(Yah moves through the halves-Covenant)

Ephesians (Efesios) 2:14-16

For he himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, **having abolished in his flesh the enmity, [that is], the law of commandments [contained] in ordinances,** so as to create in himself **one new man [from] the two, [thus] making peace, and that he might reconcile them both to Elohim in one body** through the tree, thereby putting to death the enmity.

Genesis 22:1-2

Now it came to pass after these things that

Elohim tested Abraham, and said to him,

"Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

Then He said, "Take now your son, your only [son] Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land

of Moriah, and **offer him there as a burnt offering** on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

Genesis 22:6-7

So Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid [it] on Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife, and the **two of them went together.** But Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." Then he said, "Look, the fire and the wood, but **where [is] the lamb for a burnt offering?**"

Genesis 22:8

And Abraham said, "My son, Elohim will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering." So the two of them went together.

Genesis 22:12

And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad,
or do anything to him; **for now I know that you
fear Elohim, since you have not withheld your
son, your only [son], from Me.**"

Genesis 22:13-14

Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind [him was] a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering **instead of his son.**

And Abraham called the name of the place, **The-LORD-Will-Provide;** as it is said [to] this day, "In the Mount of YHVH it shall be provided."

John (Juan) 8:56

“Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day,
and he saw [it] and was glad.”

John (Juan) 8:39, 42

They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Yeshua said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham." Yeshua said to them, "If Elohim were your Father, you would love me, for I proceeded forth and came from Elohim; nor have I come of myself, but He sent me."

John (Juan) 8:44

"You are of [your] father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own [resources], for he is a liar and the father of it." (Story of Joseph)

2 Samuel 7:23

"And who [is] like Your people, like Israel, **the one nation on the earth whom Elohim went to redeem for Himself as a people**, to make for Himself a name--and to do for Yourself great and awesome deeds for Your land--**before Your people whom You redeemed for Yourself from Egypt, the nations, and their Elohims?**"

(Pharaoh= Satan)

Exodus (Exodo) 8:1

And YHVH spoke to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh and say to him, 'Thus says YHVH: **"Let My people go, that they may serve Me."**""

(Negotiate price for freedom- 10 plagues like Laban changing wages 10 times)

Exodus (Exodo) 11:14-16

Then Moses said, "Thus says YHVH: 'About midnight I will go out into the midst of Egypt; and all **the firstborn** in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sits on his throne, even to the firstborn of the female servant who [is] behind the handmill, and all the firstborn of the animals. Then there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, such as was not like it [before], nor shall be like it again.'"

Exodus (Exodo) 12:3

"Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying:
'On the tenth of this month every man shall
take for himself a lamb, **according to the house
of [his] father,** a lamb for a household.'"

Exodus (Exodo) 12:5-6

"Your **lamb** shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take [it] from the sheep or from the goats. Now **you shall keep it until the fourteenth day** of the same month. Then the **whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight.**"

(Who is to kill the lamb?)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:7-8

"And **they shall take [some] of the blood and put [it] on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.**

Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread [and] with bitter [herbs] they shall eat it."

Exodus (Exodo) 12:11-12

"And thus you shall eat it: [with] a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. **It [is] YHVH's Passover.** For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the Elohims of Egypt I will execute judgment: I [am] YHVH."

Exodus (Exodo) 12:23

"For YHVH will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when **He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, YHVH will pass over the door** and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike [you]."

(Sin lies at the door-Its desire is for you-You should rule over it.)

Exodus (Exodo) 12:13

"Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you [are]. **And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy [you]** when I strike the land of Egypt."

Exodus (Exodo) 12:14

"So **this day shall be to you a memorial;** and you shall keep it as a feast to YHVH throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance."

(Remember what?)

John (Juan) 10:9-10

"**I am the door.** If anyone enters by me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not **come** except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have life, and that they may have [it] more abundantly.**"

(Door to what-come to Father through me)

Isaiah (Isaias) 28:18

Your covenant with death will be annulled, and your agreement with Sheol will not stand; when the overflowing scourge passes through, then you will be trampled down by it.

Hebrews (Hebreos) 9:15

And for this reason he is the mediator of the renewed covenant, **by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant**, that those who are called may receive the promise of **the eternal inheritance.**

Romans (Romanos) 5:8-10

But Elohim demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Messiah (Lamb) **died for us.** Much more then, having now been justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if **when we were enemies we were reconciled to Elohim through the death of His son,** much more, having been reconciled, **we shall be saved by his life. (Word is our life)**


