## Exodus (Exodo) 6:6

“Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I [am] YHVH; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.'”

## Exodus (Exodo) 6:7

“I will take you as My people, and I will be your Elohim. Then you shall know that I [am] YHVH your Elohim who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.”

## Luke (Lucas) 15:1-2

Then all the tax collectors and the sinners  
drew near to him to **hear** him.

And the Pharisees and scribes complained,  
saying, "This man receives sinners and eats  
with them."

(Sinners- devoted to sin- not free from)

## Luke (Lucas) 15:3-4

So he spoke this parable to them, saying:

"What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if **he loses one of them**, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and **go after the one which is lost until he finds it?**"

## Luke (Lucas) 15:5

"And when he has found [it], **he lays [it] on his shoulders, rejoicing.**"

## Luke (Lucas) 15:6-7

"And when he comes home, he calls together [his] friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance."

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 7:7-8

"YHVH did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; but because YHVH loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, YHVH has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt."

## Leviticus (Levitico) 25:54-55

“Even **if he is not redeemed by these [means,]**  
he shall still go out in the year of jubilee, he  
and his sons with him. For the sons of Israel  
are My servants; **they are My servants whom I**  
**brought out from the land of Egypt. I am YHVH**  
**your Elohim.”**

## Leviticus (Levitico) 25:25

“If a fellow countryman of yours becomes so poor he has to sell part of his property, **then his nearest kinsman is to come and buy back what his relative has sold.**”

## Exodus (Exodo) 28:11-12

“With the work of an engraver in stone, [like] the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall set them in settings of gold. And **you shall put the two stones on the shoulders** of the ephod [as] memorial stones for the sons of Israel. So Aaron shall **bear** their names before YHVH **on his two shoulders as a memorial.**”

## Numbers (Numeros) 7:9

“But to the sons of Kohath he gave none, because theirs [was] the service of the holy things, [which] **they carried on their shoulders.”**

(Menorah, incense altar, altar, basin, ark)

## Isaiah (Isaias) 49:22

Thus says YHVH Elohim: "Behold, I will lift My hand in an oath to the nations, and set up My standard for the peoples; they shall bring your sons in [their] arms, and your daughters shall be carried on [their] shoulders."

(49:26- All flesh know that I am your Savior and Redeemer, Mighty One of Jacob.)

## Psalm (Salmos) 119:170, 174-5

Let my supplication come before You; deliver me according to Your word.

I long for Your salvation, O YHVH, and Your law [is] my delight.

**Let my soul live, and it shall praise You;** and let Your judgments help me.

## Psalm (Salmos) 119:176

**I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek Your servant, for I do not forget Your commandments.**

## Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 22:1-2

**"You shall not see your brother's ox or his sheep going astray, and hide yourself from them; you shall certainly bring them back to your brother. And if your brother [is] not near you, or if you do not know him, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall remain with you until your brother seeks it; then you shall restore it to him."**

## Isaiah (Isaias) 53:5-6

But he [was] wounded for our transgressions,  
bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for  
our peace [was] upon Him, And by His stripes  
we are healed.

All **we like sheep have gone astray;** we  
have turned, every one, to his own way; and  
YHVH has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

## 2 Chronicles (Cronicas) 18:16

Then he said, "I saw all Israel scattered on the mountains, **as sheep that have no shepherd.**

And YHVH said, 'These have no master. Let each return to his house in peace.' "

## Matthew (Mateo) 18:12

"What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and **one of them goes astray**, does he not leave the ninety-nine and

**go to the mountains**

to seek the one that is straying?"

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:1-2

And the word of YHVH came to me, saying,  
"Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of  
Israel, prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says  
YHVH Elohim to the shepherds: **"Woe to the  
shepherds of Israel who feed themselves!  
Should not the shepherds feed the flocks?"**""

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:3-4

"You eat the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool; you slaughter the fatlings, [but] you do not feed the flock. The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you healed those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, **nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost;** but with force and cruelty you have ruled them."

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:5-6

"So they were scattered because [there was] no shepherd; and they became food for all the beasts of the field when they were scattered.

**My sheep wandered through all the mountains,  
and on every high hill; yes, My flock was  
scattered over the whole face of the earth, and  
no one was seeking or searching [for them]."**

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:11-12

For thus says YHVH Elohim: **"Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out.**

As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day." (My own Arm will bring salvation)

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:16-17

"I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; but I will destroy the fat and the strong, and feed them in judgment."

And [as for] you, **O My flock**, thus says YHVH Elohim:

"Behold, **I shall judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and goats.**"

(Separate sheep from goats-Standard for judgment?)

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:23

"I will establish one shepherd over them, **and he shall feed them**--My servant David. **He shall feed them and be their shepherd."**

## Isaiah (Isaias) 53:3-4

He is despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. **And we hid,** as it were, [our] faces from him; he was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; **yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by Elohim, and afflicted.**

## Isaiah (Isaias) 53:5-6

But he [was] wounded for our transgressions,  
bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for  
our peace [was] upon Him, And by His stripes  
we are healed.

All **we like sheep have gone astray;** we  
have turned, every one, to his own way; and  
YHVH has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

## John (Juan) 10:4-5

"And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him,

**for they know his voice.**

Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, **for they do not know the voice of strangers.**" (Know whose words)

## John (Juan) 10:11-12

"I am the good shepherd. **The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.**

But a hireling, [he who is] not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, **sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them."**

## John (Juan) 10:13-15

"The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep.

I am the good shepherd; and I know my [sheep], **and am known by my own.**

As the Father knows me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep."

## John (Juan) 10:16

"And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear my voice; and there will be one flock [and] one shepherd."

## Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:23

"I will establish one shepherd over them, **and he shall feed them**--My servant David. **He shall feed them and be their shepherd."**

## Jeremiah (Jeremias) 23:1-2

"Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture!" says YHVH.

Therefore thus says YHVH Elohim of Israel against the shepherds who feed My people:

**"You have scattered My flock, driven them away, and not attended to them.** Behold, I will attend to you for the evil of your doings," says YHVH.

## Jeremiah (Jeremias) 23:3-4

"But I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries where I have driven them, and bring them back to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking," says YHVH.

## John (Juan) 21:15-16

So when they had eaten breakfast, Yeshua said to Simon Peter, "**Simon, [son] of Jonah, do you love me more than these?**" He said to him, "Yes, lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "**Feed my lambs.**" He said to him again a second time, "Simon, [son] of Jonah, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "**Tend my sheep.**"

## John (Juan) 21:17

He said to him the third time, "Simon, [son] of **Jonah**, do you love me?" Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" And he said to him, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you." Yeshua said to him, "**Feed my sheep.**"

# Psalm (Salmos) 23:1-2

A Psalm of David.

**YHVH [is] my shepherd;**

I shall not want.

He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He  
leads me beside the still waters.

## Psalm (Salmos) 23:3-4

**He restores my soul;** He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You [are] with me; **Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.**
