# Leviticus 19:1-2

וידבר יהוה אל-משה לאמר  
דבר אל-כל-עדת בני-ישראל ואמרת אליהם  
קדשים תהיו כי קדוש אני יהוה אלהיכם

Va-Ye-Da-Ber Ye-Ho-Va El-Mo-She Le-Mor

Da-Ber El-Kol-A-Dat Be-Nei-Yis-Ra-El Ve-A-Mar-Ta A-Le-Hem

Ke-Dshim Tih-Yu Ki Ka-Dosh A-Ni Ye-Ho-Va E-Lo-Hei-Chem

# Leviticus 19:1-2

- 1 And YHVH spoke to Mosheh, saying, “Speak to all the congregation of the children of Yisra’ēl, and say to them,
- **2 ‘Be set-apart, for I, YHVH, your Elohim, am set-apart.’”**
- HOW?

# Leviticus 19

- 3 'Each one of you should **fear his mother and his father**, and **guard My Sabbaths**. I am YHVH, your Elohim.
- Does the world honor their parents?
- Do they guard **HIS** Sabbaths?

# Leviticus 19

- 4 'Do not turn to idols, and do not make for yourselves molded mighty ones. I am YHVH, your Elohim.
- Does the world turn to (trust in) idols?
- Do they make/fashion their own gods?

# Leviticus 19

- 5-8 – peace offerings, eat within 2 days
- 9 ‘And when you reap the harvest of your land, do not completely reap the corners of your field or gather the gleanings of your harvest. 10 ‘And do not glean your vineyard or gather every grape of your vineyard, leave them for the poor and the stranger. I am YHVH your Elohim.

# Leviticus 19

- 11 'Do not steal, do not lie, do not deceive one another.
- 12 'And do not swear falsely by My Name and so profane the Name of your Elohim. I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 13 'Do not oppress your neighbor *or rob him*.  
The wages of him who is hired is not to remain with you all night until morning.
- 14 'Do not curse the deaf, or put a stumbling-block before the blind, but *fear your Elohim*. I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 15 'Do no unrighteousness in right-ruling. Do not be partial to the poor or favor the face of the great, but rightly rule your neighbor in righteousness.
- 16 'Do not go slandering among your people.  
Do not stand against the blood of your neighbor. I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 17 'Do not hate your brother in your heart. Reprove your neighbor, for certain, and bear no sin, because of him.
- 18 'Do not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the children of your people. And you shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am YHVH.

# Leviticu 19

- 19 'Guard **My** laws. Do not let your livestock mate with another kind. Do not sow your field with mixed seed. And do not put a garment woven of two sorts of thread upon you.
- 20-22 Relations with an engaged woman
- 23-25 Fruit trees in the land (5 years)

# Leviticus 19

- 26 'Do not eat meat with the blood. Do not practice divination or magic.
- 27 'Do not round the corner of your head, nor destroy the corner of your beard.
- 28 'And do not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor put tattoo marks on you. I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 29 'Do not profane your daughter by making her a whore, so that the land does not whore, and the land becomes filled with wickedness.
- 30 '**Guard My Sabbaths** and reverence My set-apart place. I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 31 'Do not turn to mediums, and do not seek after spiritists to be defiled by them.  
I am YHVH, your Elohim.
- 32 'Rise up before **the grey-headed**.  
And you shall favor the face of an old man, and shall fear your Elohim.  
I am YHVH.

# Leviticus 19

- 33 'And when a stranger sojourns with you in your land, do not oppress him.
- 34 'Let the stranger who dwells among you be to you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself. For you were strangers in the land of Mitsrayim. I am YHVH, your Elohim.

# Leviticus 19

- 35 'Do no unrighteousness in right-ruling, in measurement of length, in weight, or in measuring liquids.
- 36 'Have right scales, right weights, a right ĕphah, and a right hin. I am YHVH, your Elohim, who brought you out of the land of Mitsrayim.

# Leviticus 19

- 37 ‘And you shall guard all My laws and all My right-rulings, and do them. I am YHVH.
  - The world?
  - **HOW** to be set-apart.
  - Unlike the world.
