son

Isaiah (Isaias) 7:17

"YHVH will bring the king of Assyria upon you and your people and your father's house--days that have not come since the day that Ephraim departed from Judah."

Hosea (Oseas) 7:8

"Ephraim has mixed himself among the peoples; Ephraim is a cake unturned."

Hosea (Oseas) 9:3

“They shall not dwell in YHVH's land, but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, **and shall eat unclean [things]** in Assyria.”

(Eat what in far off country & Pods of pigs)

Hosea (Oseas) 12:8

“And Ephraim said, 'Surely I have become rich,
I have found wealth for myself; [In] all my
labors They shall find in me no iniquity that [is]
sin.’”

Why leave?

Hosea (Oseas) 13:4-6

"Yet I [am] YHVH your Elohim, **ever since the land of Egypt, and you shall know no Elohim but Me; for [there is] no savior besides Me.**
I knew you in the wilderness, In the land of great drought. When they had pasture, they were filled; **they were filled and their heart was exalted; therefore they forgot Me.**"

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:11-13

"Beware that you do not forget YHVH your Elohim by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today, lest-- **when you have eaten and are full,** and have built beautiful houses and dwell [in them]; and [when] your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied..." (Focus on Blessings)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:14, 16

“When your heart is lifted up, and **you forget YHVH your Elohim** who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end—” (Forget = test time)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:17

“Then you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.'”

(I want my part of this wealth, wants to be father, not son/servant)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 8:19-20

“Then it shall be, if you by any means forget YHVH your Elohim, and follow other elohim (mighty ones), and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish.

As the nations which YHVH destroys before you, **so you shall perish**, because you would not be obedient to the voice of YHVH your Elohim.”
(Leaves and goes to far off country = fall/sin)

Isaiah (Isaias) 53:6

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have
turned, every one, to his own way; and
YHVH has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Luke (Lucas) 15:8-9

"Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, **does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds [it]?** And when she has found [it], she calls [her] friends and neighbors together, saying, 'Rejoice with me, **for I have found the piece which I lost!**'"

Luke (Lucas) 15:3-4

So he spoke this parable to them, saying:

"What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if **he loses one of them**, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and **go after the one which is lost until he finds it?**"

Luke (Lucas) 15:6

"And when he comes home, he calls together [his] friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for **I have found my sheep which was lost!**'"

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:25

“If a fellow countryman of yours becomes so poor he has to sell part of his property, **then his nearest kinsman is to come and buy back what his relative has sold.**”

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:54-55

“Even **if he is not redeemed by these [means,]**
he shall still go out in the year of jubilee, he
and his sons with him. For the sons of Israel
are My servants; **they are My servants whom I**
brought out from the land of Egypt. I am YHVH
your Elohim.”

Hosea (Oseas) 13:12-14

"The **iniquity of Ephraim** [is] bound up; his sin [is] stored up. The sorrows of a woman in childbirth shall come upon him. He [is] an unwise son, for he should not stay long where children are born. I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. O Death, I will be your plagues! O Grave, I will be your destruction! **Compassion (repentance) is hidden from My eyes.**"

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:14

“But **if you do not obey Me,** and do not observe all these commandments...”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:18-19

“And after all this, if you do not obey Me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins.

I will break the pride of your power; I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze.” (famine?)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:43

"The alien who [is] among you shall rise higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:47-48

“Because you did not serve YHVH your Elohim with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything, **therefore you shall serve your enemies**, whom YHVH will send against you, **in hunger, in thirst, in nakedness, and in need of everything**; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.” (join to citizen & hungry)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:51

"And **they shall eat the increase of your** livestock and **the produce of your land, until you are destroyed; **they shall not leave you grain** or new wine or oil, [or] the increase of your cattle or the offspring of your flocks, **until they have destroyed you.**"**

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:26

“When I have cut off your supply of bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall bring back your bread by weight, **and you shall eat and not be satisfied.”**

Repent

Hosea (Oseas) 14:1-2

O Israel, return to YHVH your Elohim, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity; **take words with you, and return to YHVH.** Say to Him, "Take away all iniquity; receive [us] graciously, for we will offer the sacrifices of our lips." (Words? 2 kinds)

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:40-41

“If they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers, with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked contrary to Me, and [that] I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt—”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:44-45

“Yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, nor shall I abhor them, to utterly destroy them and break My covenant with them; **for I [am] YHVH their Elohim.** But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors, **whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their Elohim: I [am] YHVH.”**

Isaiah (Isaias) 46:12

"Listen to Me, you stubborn-hearted, **who [are]**
far from righteousness..."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:11-12

For thus says YHVH Elohim: **"Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out.**

As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day." (My own Arm will bring salvation)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:16

"I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; but I will destroy the fat and the strong, and feed them in judgment."

Matthew (Mateo) 21:33

"Hear another parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers **and went into a far country.**"

Matthew (Mateo) 25:14

"For [the kingdom of heaven is] **like a man traveling to a far country,** [who] called his own servants and **delivered his goods to them.**"
