Leviticus (Levitico) 21:1-24:33

And not many days after, **the younger son gathered
all together**, journeyed to a far country, and there
wasted his possessions with prodigal living."

Luke (Lucas) 15:25-27

"Now his older son was in the field. And **as he came and drew near to the house**, he heard music and dancing. So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant. And he said to him, **'Your brother has come, and because he has received him safe and sound, your father has killed the fatted calf.'**"

Luke (Lucas) 15:28

"But he was angry and **would not go in.**
Therefore his father came out and pleaded
with him."

Luke (Lucas) 15:29-30

"So he answered and said to [his] father, 'Lo, these many years I have been serving you; I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat, that I might make merry with my friends. But as soon as **this son of yours** came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.'"

Luke (Lucas) 15:31-32

"And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with me, and all that I have is yours.'"

Harlots

Hosea (Oseas) 4:14-15

"I will not punish your daughters when **they commit harlotry**, nor your brides when **they commit adultery**; **For [the men] themselves go apart with harlots, and offer sacrifices with a ritual harlot.** Therefore people [who] do not understand will be trampled.

Though you, Israel, play the harlot, let not Judah offend. Do not come up to Gilgal, nor go up to Beth Aven, nor swear an oath, [saying], 'As YHVH lives'"

Hosea (Oseas) 6:10-11

"I have seen a horrible thing in the house of Israel: **there [is] the harlotry of Ephraim**; Israel is defiled.

Also, **O Judah, a harvest is appointed for you,**
when I return the captives of My people."
(Judah's struggles)

Genesis 38:11

Then Judah said to Tamar his daughter-in-law, "Remain a widow in your father's house till my son Shelah is grown." For he said, "Lest he also die like his brothers." And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

Genesis 38:14-15

So she took off her widow's garments, covered [herself] with a veil and wrapped herself, and sat in an open place which [was] on the way to Timnah; for she saw that Shelah was grown, and she was not given to him as a wife.

When **Judah saw her, he thought she [was] a harlot,** because she had covered her face.

Genesis 38:16-17

Then he turned to her by the way, and said, "Please let me come in to you"; for he did not know that she [was] his daughter-in-law. So she said, "What will you give me, that you may come in to me?"

And he said, "I will send a young goat from the flock." So she said, "Will you give [me] a pledge till you send [it]?" (Friends)

Genesis 38:20

And Judah sent the young goat by the hand of his friend the Adullamite, to receive [his] pledge from the woman's hand, but he did not find her.

Genesis 38:24

And it came to pass, about three months after, that Judah was told, saying, "Tamar your daughter-in-law has played the harlot; furthermore she [is] with child by harlotry." So Judah said, "Bring her out and let her be burned!"

Leviticus (Levitico) 21:9

“The daughter of any priest, if she profanes herself by playing the harlot, she profanes her father. She shall be burned with fire.”

Genesis 38:25-26

When she [was] brought out, she sent to her father-in-law, saying, "By the man to whom these belong, I [am] with child." And she said, "Please determine whose these [are]--the signet and cord, and staff."

So Judah acknowledged [them] and said, "She has been more righteous than I, because I did not give her to Shelah my son." And he never knew her again.

Leviticus (Levitico) 21:1-3

And YHVH said to Moses, "Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them:

'None shall defile himself for the dead among his people,

except for his relatives who are nearest to him:

his mother, his father, his son, his daughter,

and his brother; also his virgin sister who is

near to him, who has had no husband, for her

he may defile himself.'"

Leviticus (Levitico) 21:4

“Otherwise he shall not defile himself, [being]
a chief man among his people, to profane
himself.”

Leviticus (Levitico) 22:4-6

“Whatever man of the descendants of Aaron, who [is] a leper or has a discharge, shall not eat the holy offerings until he is clean. **And whoever touches anything made unclean [by] a corpse,** or a man who has had an emission of semen, **the person who has touched any such thing shall be unclean until evening,** and shall not eat the holy [offerings] unless he washes his body with water.”

Luke (Lucas) 10:31-31

Then Yeshua answered and said: "A certain [man] went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded [him], and departed, leaving [him] half dead. Now by chance a certain **priest** came down that road. And when he **saw him, he passed by on the other side."**

Luke (Lucas) 10:36-37

"So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves?"

And he said, **"He who showed mercy on him."**

Then Yeshua said to him, "Go and do likewise."

Genesis 3:17-18

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': **Cursed [is] the ground for your sake; in toil you shall eat [of] it all the days of your life.**

Matthew (Mateo) 20:10-12

"But when the first came, they supposed that they **would receive more**; and they likewise received each a denarius. And when they had received [it], they complained against the landowner, saying, 'These last [men] have worked [only] one hour, and you made them equal to us **who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.'**"

Matthew (Mateo) 20:13-15

"But he answered one of them, '**I am not being unfair to you**, friend. Didn't you agree to work for a denarius? Take your pay and go. I want to give the one who was hired last the same as I gave you. **Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?**'" (Unfair?)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:25

"Yet you say, 'The way of YHVH is not fair.' Hear now, O house of Israel, **is it not My way which is fair, and your ways which are not fair?"**

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:27-28

"Again, when a wicked [man] turns away from the wickedness which he committed, and does what is lawful and right, he preserves himself alive. **Because he considers and turns away from all the transgressions which he committed, he shall surely live; he shall not die.**"

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:24

"But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked [man] does, shall he live? **All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered;** because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, **because of them he shall die.**"

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 18:29-30

"Yet the house of Israel says, 'The way of YHVH is not fair.' **O house of Israel, is it not My ways which are fair, and your ways which are not fair?**

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways," says YHVH Elohim.

"Repent, and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin."

Envious

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 32:15-16, 21

"Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; filled with food, they became heavy and sleek. They abandoned the Elohim who made them and rejected the Rock their Savior.

They made him jealous with their foreign elohim and angered him with their detestable idols. They made me jealous by what is no elohim and angered me with their worthless idols. I will make them envious by those who are not a people; I will make them angry by a nation that has no understanding."

Seeds of jealousy

- **Father more concerned for 99 or the 1? Father waiting for younger son's return everyday? Brother in the field alone everyday.**
- **Tempted to believe we deserve more. Why? Obey all the commandments? My own party?**
- **Forget mercy, forget to love as we are loved**

Romans (Romanos) 11:11

“I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! **But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation [has come] to the Gentiles.”**

Romans (Romanos) 11:13-14

“For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am
an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my
ministry, if by any means I may provoke to
jealousy [those who are] my flesh and save
some of them.”

Romans (Romanos) 11:15

“For if their being cast away [is] the reconciling of the world, **what [will] their acceptance [be] but life from the dead?”**

Romans (Romanos) 11:22-23

“Therefore consider the goodness and severity of Elohim: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in [His] goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.
