Leviticus (Levitico) 25:47-48

"Now if a sojourner or stranger close to you becomes rich, and [one of] your brethren [who dwells] by him becomes poor, and sells himself to the stranger [or] sojourner close to you, or to a member of the stranger's family, after he is sold he may be redeemed again. One of his brothers may redeem him..."

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:42

“For they [are] My servants, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt; they shall not be sold as slaves (permanently).”

Luke (Lucas) 15:1-2

Then all the tax collectors and the sinners
drew near to him to **hear** him.

And the Pharisees and scribes complained,
saying, "**This man receives sinners and eats
with them.**"

Luke (Lucas) 15:11-13

Then he said: "A certain man had **two sons**.
And the younger of them said to [his] father, 'Father,
give me the portion of goods that falls [to me].' So
he divided to them [his] livelihood.

And not many days after, **the younger son gathered
all together**, journeyed to a far country, and there
wasted his possessions with prodigal living."

(Compassion for younger brother?)

Luke (Lucas) 15:4-6

"What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? And when he has found [it], he lays [it] on his shoulders, rejoicing. **And when he comes home,** he calls together [his] friends and neighbors, saying to them, **'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!'"** (How much more a sibling?)

Luke (Lucas) 15:25-27

"Now his older son was in the field. And **as he came and drew near to the house**, he heard music and dancing. So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant. And he said to him, '**Your brother has come**, and because he has received him safe and sound, **your father has killed the fatted calf.**'"

Luke (Lucas) 15:28

"But he was angry and **would not go in.**
Therefore his father came out and pleaded
with him."

Luke (Lucas) 15:29-30

"So he answered and said to [his] father, 'Lo, these many years I have been **serving you**; I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat, that **I might make merry with my friends.** But as soon as **this son of yours** came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.'"

Luke (Lucas) 15:31-32

"And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with **me**, and all that I have is yours.'"

(Am I my brother's keeper? Are we shepherds?)

Genesis 46:33-34

"So it shall be, when Pharaoh calls you and says,
 '**What is your occupation?**'
 that you shall say, 'Your servants' occupation
has been with livestock from our youth even till
now, both we [and] also our fathers,' that you
 may dwell in the land of Goshen; **for every
shepherd** [is] an abomination to the Egyptians."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:2

"Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says YHVH Elohim to the shepherds: **"Woe to the shepherds of Israel who feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks?"**""

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:3-4

"You eat the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool; you slaughter the fatlings, [but] you do not feed the flock. The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you healed those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, **nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost;** but with force and cruelty you have ruled them."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:5-6

"So they were scattered because [there was] no shepherd; and they became food for all the beasts of the field when they were scattered.

My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill; yes, My flock was scattered over the whole face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching [for them]."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:11-12

For thus says YHVH Elohim: **"Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out.**

As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day." (My own Arm will bring salvation)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:13-14

"And I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land; I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, in the valleys and in all the inhabited places of the country. **I will feed them in good pasture,** and their fold shall be on the high mountains of Israel. **There they shall lie down in a good fold** and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:15

"I will feed My flock, and **I will make them lie down,**" says YHVH Elohim.

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:16-17

"I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; but I will destroy the fat and the strong, and feed them in judgment."

And [as for] you, O My flock, thus says YHVH Elohim: "Behold, I shall judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and goats."

(Purpose for Messiah being sent?)

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:23-24

"I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them--My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd.

And I, YHVH, will be their Elohim, and My servant David a prince among them; I, YHVH, have spoken."

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:30

"Thus they shall know that I, YHVH their Elohim,
[am] with them, and **they, the house of Israel,**
[are] My people," says YHVH Elohim.

"You are My flock, the flock of My pasture; you
[are] men, [and] I [am] your Elohim," says YHVH
Elohim.

Ezekiel (Ezequiel) 34:23-24

"I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them--My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd.

And I, YHVH, will be their Elohim, and My servant David a prince among them; I, YHVH, have spoken."

Micah (Miqueas) 5:2

“But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are little among the thousands **of Judah**, [Yet] out of you shall come forth to Me **the One to be Ruler in Israel**, whose goings forth [are] from of old, from everlasting.”

(Word of Yah came to me- Like rain)

Numbers (Numeros) 26:16-17

"Let YHVH, the Elohim of the spirits of all flesh,
set a man over the congregation,
who may go out before them and go in before
them, who may lead them out and bring them
in, that the congregation of YHVH may not be
like sheep which have no shepherd."

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 18:18-19

“I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.

And it shall be [that] whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, **I will require [it] of him.”**

John (Juan) 10:2-3

"But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the doorkeeper opens, and **the sheep hear his voice**; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out."

John (Juan) 10:4-5

"And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, **for they know his voice.** Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."

John (Juan) 10:9, 11

"I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture."

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives his life for the sheep."

John (Juan) 10:12-13

"But a hireling, [he who is] not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them.

The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep."

Amos 3:12

John (Juan) 10:14-15

"I am the good shepherd; and I know my [sheep], and am known by my own.

As the Father knows me, even so I know the Father; and **I lay down my life for the sheep."**

John (Juan) 10:16-17

"And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear my voice; and there will be one flock [and] one shepherd. Therefore my Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it again."

John (Juan) 10:25-27

Yeshua answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name (authority), they bear witness of me. But you do not believe, because you are not of my sheep, as I said to you.

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me."

Luke (Lucas) 15:1-2

Then all the tax collectors and the sinners
drew near to him to **hear** him.

And the Pharisees and scribes complained,
saying, **"This man receives sinners and eats
with them."**

(Those not hear words, I will require it of him)

Matthew (Mateo) 21:33

"Hear another parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And **he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country.**"

Matthew (Mateo) 21:40-41

"Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?"

They said to him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease [his] vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons."

(Fruits?)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 23:3-4

"But I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries where I have driven them, and bring them back to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking," says YHVH.

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 16:15-16

“But, 'YHVH lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had driven them.' For I will bring them back into their land which I gave to their fathers.

Behold, I will send for many fishermen," says YHVH, **"and they shall fish them;** and afterward I will send for many hunters, and they shall hunt them from every mountain and every hill, and out of the holes of the rocks."

Matthew (Mateo) 28:19-20

“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, mikvahing them in the name of the Father and of the son and (His) of the Holy Spirit, **teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you;** and lo, I am with you always, [even] to the end of the age.” Amen.
