



Redemption 7

Luke (Lucas) 15:25-27

"Now his older son was in the field. And **as he came and drew near to the house**, he heard music and dancing. So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant. And he said to him, **'Your brother has come, and because he has received him safe and sound, your father has killed the fattened calf.'**"

Luke (Lucas) 15:28

"But he was angry and **would not go in.**
Therefore his father came out and pleaded
with him."

Luke (Lucas) 15:29-30

"So he answered and said to [his] father, 'Lo, these many years I have been **serving you**; I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat, that **I might make merry with my friends.** But as soon as **this son of yours** came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.'"

Luke (Lucas) 15:31-32

"And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with **me**, and all that I have is yours.'"

(Am I my brother's keeper? Are we shepherds?)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:1-2

"The word that came to Jeremiah from YHVH in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which was the eighteenth year of Nebuchadnezzar. For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem, and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which [was in] the king of Judah's house."

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:3-4

For Zedekiah king of Judah had shut him up, saying, "Why do you prophesy and say, 'Thus says YHVH: "Behold, **I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall take it;** and Zedekiah king of Judah shall not escape from the hand of the Chaldeans, but **shall surely be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon,** and shall speak with him face to face, and see him eye to eye..."'"

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:26-28

Then the word of YHVH came to Jeremiah, saying, "**Behold, I [am] YHVH, the Elohim of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me? (Not believe) Therefore thus says YHVH: '**Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the Chaldeans, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and he shall take it.'**"**

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:24

"Look, the siege mounds! They have come to the city to take it; and the city has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans who fight against it, **because of the sword and famine and pestilence.** What You have spoken has happened; there You see [it]!" (Why?)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:32-33

“Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke Me to anger--they, their kings, their princes, their priests, their prophets, the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And they have turned to Me the back, and not the face; though I taught them, rising up early and teaching [them], yet they have not listened to receive instruction.”

(Not Shema)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:34-35

“But they set their abominations in the house which is called by My name, to defile it.

And they built the high places of Baal which [are] in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through [the fire] to Molech, which I did not command them, nor did it come into My mind that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.”

(Party with friends?)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:22-23

“You have given them this land, of which You swore to their fathers to give them—‘a land flowing with milk and honey.’ And they came in and took possession of it, **but they have not obeyed Your voice or walked in Your law. They have done nothing of all that You commanded them to do;** therefore You have caused all this calamity to come upon them.”

(Not gone after brother)

(Nor kept land as Father wanted)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronomio) 28:47-48

“Because you did not serve YHVH your Elohim with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything, therefore you shall serve your enemies, whom YHVH will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in nakedness, and in need of everything; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.” (All I have is yours)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:36

“Now therefore, thus says YHVH, the Elohim of Israel, concerning this city of which you say, 'It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon **by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence.**'”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:14-15

"But if you do not obey Me, and do not observe all these commandments, and if you despise My statutes, or if your soul abhors My judgments, **so that you do not perform all My commandments, [but] break My covenant...**"

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:24-25

“Then I also will walk contrary to you, and I will punish you yet seven times for your sins.

And I will bring a sword against you that will execute the vengeance of the covenant; when you are gathered together within your cities I will send pestilence among you; and you shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:33

“I will scatter you among the nations **and draw out a sword after you;** your land shall be desolate and your cities waste.”

(Kicked out of the vineyard, you would not go to the nations to redeem your brother, then I will send you to nations and you will seek to be redeemed.)

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:34-35

“Then the land shall enjoy its Shabbats as long as it lies desolate and you [are] in your enemies' land; then **the land shall rest and enjoy its Shabbats.**

As long as [it] lies desolate it shall rest--**for the time it did not rest on your Shabbats when you dwelt in it.”**

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:23-24

“The land shall not be sold permanently, for the land [is] Mine; for you [are] strangers and sojourners with Me.

And **in all the land of your possession you shall grant redemption of the land.**”

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:8-9

“And you shall count seven Shabbats of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven Shabbats of years shall be to you forty-nine years. Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:40-41

“But (if) they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers, with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked contrary to Me,

and [that] I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of their enemies; **if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt—”**

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:42

“Then I will remember My covenant with Jacob, and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham I will remember; **I will remember the land.**”

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:44-45

“Yet for all that, **when they are in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, nor shall I abhor them, to utterly destroy them and break My covenant with them; for I [am] YHVH their Elohim. But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their Elohim: I [am] YHVH.”**

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:1-2

The word that came to Jeremiah from YHVH in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which was the eighteenth year of Nebuchadnezzar. For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem, and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which [was in] the king of Judah's house.

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:6-7

And Jeremiah said, "The word of YHVH came to me, saying,

'Behold, Hanamel the son of Shallum your uncle will come to you, saying, "Buy my field which [is] in Anathoth, for the right of redemption [is] yours to buy [it]."'

(Answered prayers)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:8

"Then Hanamel my uncle's son came to me in the **court of the prison** according to the word of YHVH, and said to me, 'Please buy my field that [is] in Anathoth, which [is] in the country of Benjamin; **for the right of inheritance [is] yours, and the redemption yours; buy [it] for yourself.**' Then I knew that this was the word of YHVH."

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:9-10

"So I bought the field from Hanamel, the son of my uncle who [was] in Anathoth, and weighed [out to] him the money--seventeen shekels of silver.

And I signed the deed and sealed [it], took witnesses, and weighed the money on the scales."

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:11-12

"So I took the purchase deed, [both] that which was sealed [according] to the law and custom, and that which was open; and I gave the purchase deed to Baruch the son of Neriah, son of Mahseiah, in the presence of Hanamel my uncle's [son], **and in the presence of the witnesses who signed the purchase deed, before all the Jews who sat in the court of the prison.**

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:13-14

"Then I charged Baruch before them, saying,
'Thus says YHVH of hosts, the Elohim of Israel:

"Take these deeds, both this purchase deed
which is sealed and this deed which is open,
and put them in an earthen vessel, that they
may last many days."'"

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:15

“For thus says YHVH of hosts, the Elohim of Israel: ‘Houses and fields and vineyards shall be possessed again in this land.’”

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:16-17

"Now when I had delivered the purchase deed to Baruch the son of Neriah, I prayed to YHVH, saying:

'Ah, Lord Elohim! Behold, **You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.**'"

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:20-21

“You have set signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, to this day, and in Israel and among [other] men; and You have made Yourself a name, as it is this day. You have brought Your people Israel out of the land of Egypt with signs and wonders, with a strong hand and an outstretched arm, and with great terror.” (Yah told Abraham about Egypt 400 years before it happened.)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:25

And You have said to me, O Lord Elohim, "**Buy the field for money, and take witnesses**"!--yet the city has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans.

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:36-37

“Now therefore, thus says YHVH, the Elohim of Israel, concerning this city of which you say, 'It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence': 'Behold, I will gather them out of all countries where I have driven them in My anger, in My fury, and in great wrath; I will bring them back to this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely.’”

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:38-39

“They shall be My people, and I will be their Elohim; **then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them.”**

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:40-41

“And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them good; but I **will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me.**

Yes, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul.”

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:42

“For thus says YHVH: 'Just as I have brought all this great calamity on this people, so I will bring on them all the good that I have promised them.’”

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:44

“Men will buy fields for money, sign deeds and seal [them], and take witnesses, in the land of Benjamin, in the places around Jerusalem, in the cities of Judah, in the cities of the mountains, in the cities of the lowland, and in the cities of the South; for I will cause their captives to return,' says YHVH.”

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 31:24-25

"And there shall dwell in Judah itself, and in all its cities together, farmers and those going out with flocks.

For I have satiated the weary soul, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul."

Leviticus (Levitico) 25:10, 13

“And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout [all] the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.

In this Year of Jubilee, each of you shall return to his possession.” (Joyful sound-lost sheep, lost coin, lost son)

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 32:6-7

And Jeremiah said, "The word of YHVH came to me, saying,

'Behold, Hanamel the son of Shallum your uncle will come to you, saying, "Buy my field which [is] in Anathoth, for the right of redemption [is] yours to buy [it]."'
