John (Juan) 3:3

Yeshua answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of Elohim.**"

John (Juan) 3:4-5

Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"

Yeshua answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of Elohim."

John (Juan) 3:6-7

(Works of the Spirit)

Genesis 15:6

And **he believed in YHVH**, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

Genesis 15:7-8

Then He said to him, "I [am] YHVH, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it."

And he said, "YHVH Elohim, how shall I know that I will inherit it?"

Genesis 15:13-14

Then He said to Abram: "Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land [that is] not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years.

And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions." (Set the captives free)

Genesis 15:17

And it came to pass, when the sun went down and it was dark, that **behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a burning torch that passed between those pieces.**

(Connection- I will give you this land!!)

Genesis 15:17

Numbers (Numeros) 9:15-16

Now on the day that the tabernacle was raised up, the cloud covered the tabernacle, the tent of the Testimony; from evening until morning it was above the tabernacle like the appearance of fire.

So it was always: the cloud covered it [by day], and the appearance of fire by night.

Numbers (Numeros) 9:17-18

Whenever the cloud was taken up from above the tabernacle, after that the children of Israel would journey; and in the place where the cloud settled, there the children of Israel would pitch their tents.

At the command of YHVH the children of Israel would journey, and at the command of YHVH they would camp; as long as the cloud stayed above the tabernacle they remained encamped. (quiet voice)

Numbers (Numeros) 9:23

At the command of YHVH they remained encamped, and at the command of YHVH they journeyed; they kept the charge of YHVH, at the command of YHVH by the hand of Moses.

Genesis 12:1, 4

Now YHVH had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you.”

So Abram departed as YHVH had spoken to him, and Lot went with him. And Abram [was] seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran. (Yah going with him)

Genesis 15:4-5

And behold, the word of YHVH [came] to him, saying, **"This one shall not be your heir, but one who will come from your own body shall be your heir."** Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be."
(Works of the Spirit)

Genesis 1:1-2

In the beginning Elohim created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] on the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of Elohim was hovering over the face of the waters.**

(Brought to life and made it GOOD!!)

(A son will come from your body.)

Genesis 16:1-2

Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had borne him no children. And she had an Egyptian maidservant whose name was Hagar. So Sarai said to Abram,

"See now, YHVH has restrained me from bearing [children]. Please, go in to my maid; perhaps I shall obtain children by her." And

Abram heeded the voice of Sarai.

(Timing-Will/My shield- My Sister-tests)

Genesis 17:1-2

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, YHVH appeared to Abram and said to him, "I [am] Almighty Elohim; walk before Me and be blameless.

And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly."

Genesis 17:3-5

Then Abram fell on his face, and Elohim talked with him, saying: "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations. No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations."
(How? Born Again- Exalted father-empty name- to Father of many nations)

Genesis 17:6-7

"I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you. And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be Elohim to you and your descendants after you."

Genesis 17:8

“Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their Elohim.”

Genesis 17:10-11

"This [is] My covenant which you shall keep, between Me and you and your descendants after you: Every male child among you shall be circumcised; and you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between Me and you."

(Born again)

Genesis 17:12-13

"He who is eight days old among you shall be circumcised, every male child in your generations, **he who is born in your house or bought with money from any foreigner who is not your descendant.**

He who is born in your house and he who is bought with your money must be circumcised, and My covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant." (Father of many nations)

Genesis 17:15-16

Then Elohim said to Abraham, "As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name Sarai, but

Sarah [shall be] her name.

And **I will bless her and also give you a son by her**; then I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of peoples shall be from her."

Genesis 17:17

Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart, "Shall [a child] be born to a man who is one hundred years old? And shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear [a child]?"

Numbers (Numeros) 11:21-22

And Moses said, "The people whom I [am] among [are] six hundred thousand men on foot; yet You have said, 'I will give them meat, that they may eat [for] a whole month.'

Shall flocks and herds be slaughtered for them, to provide enough for them? Or shall all the fish of the sea be gathered together for them, to provide enough for them?"

Numbers (Numeros) 11:23

And YHVH said to Moses, "Has YHVH's arm been shortened? Now you shall see whether what I say will happen to you or not."

Genesis 18:9-10

Then they said to him, "Where [is] Sarah your wife?" So he said, "Here, in the tent."

And He said, "**I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, and behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son.**"

Genesis 18:11-12

Now Abraham and Sarah were old, well advanced in age; [and] Sarah had passed the age of childbearing.

Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, "After I have grown old, shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?"

Genesis 18:13-14

And YHVH said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I surely bear [a child], since I am old?'

Is anything too hard for YHVH? At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son."
(Moses- Slaughter all the animals-arms too short?)

Isaiah (Isaias) 7:14

"Therefore YHVH Himself will give you a sign:
Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a
Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."

Genesis 21:1-2

And YHVH visited Sarah as He had said, and YHVH did for Sarah as He had spoken. For Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which Elohim had spoken to him.

(Timing-Will- After changes and growth)

Genesis 21:6-7

And Sarah said, "Elohim has made me laugh,
[and] all who hear will laugh with me."

She also said, "Who would have said to
Abraham that Sarah would nurse children? For I
have borne [him] a son in his old age."

(Yah is Faithful and can do anything)

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:3, 9

“If you walk in My statutes and keep My commandments, and perform them...

For I will look on you favorably and make you fruitful, multiply you **and confirm My covenant with you.”**

Leviticus (Levitico) 26:11-12

“I will set My tabernacle among you, and My soul shall not abhor you.

I will walk among you and be your Elohim, and you shall be My people.”

Genesis 22:1-2

Now it came to pass after these things that

Elohim tested Abraham, and said to him,

"Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

Then He said, "Take now your son, your only [son] Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

Genesis 22:7-8

But Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son."

Then he said, "Look, the fire and the wood, but where [is] the lamb for a burnt offering?"

And Abraham said, "My son, Elohim will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering." So the two of them went together.

Genesis 22:13-14

Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind [him was] a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son.

And Abraham called the name of the place, The-LORD-Will-Provide; as it is said [to] this day, "In the Mount of YHVH it shall be provided." (Spirit working, will work, and has worked to finish His work)

Genesis 22:16-17

And said: "By Myself I have sworn, says YHVH, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only [son]-- blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which [is] on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies."

Genesis 22:18

“In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, **because you have obeyed My voice.**”

Genesis 26:4-5

"And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed; because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws."

James (Santiago) 2:21-22

"Was not our father Abraham considered righteous for what he did when he offered his son Isaac on the altar?

You see that his faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did."

Zechariah (Zacarias) 4:6
