John (Juan) 3:1-2

There was a man of the Pharisees named
Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews.

This man came to Yeshua by night and said to
him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher
come from Elohim; for no one can do these
signs that you do unless Elohim is with him."

John (Juan) 3:3

Yeshua answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of Elohim."

John (Juan) 3:4-5

Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"

Yeshua answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of Elohim."

(Emphasis on born of Spirit, not saved)

John (Juan) 3:6-7

"That which is born of the flesh is flesh, **and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.**

Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'"

John (Juan) 3:8

“The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the words of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit.”

Reputation-Signs

Numbers (Numeros) 22:2-3

Now Balak the son of Zippor **saw** all that Israel had done to the Amorites.

And Moab was exceedingly afraid of the people because they [were] many, and Moab was sick with dread because of the children of Israel.

Numbers (Numeros) 22:5

Then **he sent messengers to Balaam the son of Beor at Pethor**, which [is] near the River in the land of the sons of his people, to call him, saying: "Look, a people has come from Egypt. See, they cover the face of the earth, and are settling next to me!"

Numbers (Numeros) 22:6

“Therefore please come at once, curse this people for me, for they [are] too mighty for me. Perhaps I shall be able to defeat them and drive them out of the land, for I know that he whom you bless [is] blessed, and he whom you curse is cursed.”

Numbers (Numeros) 22:18

Then Balaam answered and said to the servants of Balak, "Though Balak were to give me his house full of silver and gold, I could not go beyond the word of YHVH my Elohim, **to do less or more."**

Numbers (Numeros) 22:20

And Elohim came to Balaam at night and said to him, "If the men come to call you, rise [and] go with them; but only the word which I speak to you--that you shall do."

Numbers (Numeros) 22:22

Then Elohim's anger was aroused because he **went**, and the Angel of YHVH took His stand in the way as an adversary against him. And he was riding on his donkey, and his two servants [were] with him.

Numbers (Numeros) 22:23

Now the donkey saw the Angel of YHVH standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand, and the donkey turned aside out of the way and went into the field. So Balaam struck the donkey to turn her back onto the road.

(Donkey saw, donkey saw)

Numbers (Numeros) 22:28-29

Then **YHVH opened the mouth of the donkey**, and she said to Balaam, "What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times?"

And Balaam said to the donkey, "Because you have abused me. I wish there were a sword in my hand, for now I would kill you!"

Numbers (Numeros) 22:31-32

Then YHVH opened Balaam's eyes, and he saw the Angel of YHVH standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand; and he bowed his head and fell flat on his face.

And the Angel of YHVH said to him, "Why have you struck your donkey these three times? Behold, I have come out to stand against you, because [your] way is perverse before Me."

Numbers (Numeros) 23:3

Then Balaam said to Balak, "Stand by your burnt offering, and I will go; perhaps YHVH will come to meet me, and **whatever He shows me** I will tell you." So he went to a desolate height.

Numbers (Numeros) 23:5

Then YHVH put a word in Balaam's mouth, and said, "Return to Balak, and thus you shall speak."

Numbers (Numeros) 23:16

Then YHVH met Balaam, and put a word in his mouth, and said, "Go back to Balak, and thus you shall speak."

Numbers (Numeros) 23:23

"For [there is] no sorcery against Jacob, Nor any divination against Israel. It now must be said of Jacob and of Israel, 'Oh, what Elohim has done!'"

Numbers (Numeros) 24:1-2

Now **when Balaam saw that it pleased YHVH to bless Israel**, he did not go as at other times, to seek to use sorcery, but he set his face toward the wilderness.

And **Balaam raised his eyes, and saw Israel encamped according to their tribes; and the Spirit of Elohim came upon him.**

Numbers (Numeros) 24:3-4

Then he took up his oracle and said: "The utterance of Balaam the son of Beor, **the utterance of the man whose eyes are opened,** the utterance of him who hears the words of Elohim, **who sees the vision of the Almighty,** **Who falls down, with eyes wide open:"**

Numbers (Numeros) 24:5-6

"How lovely are your tents, O Jacob! Your dwellings, O Israel!

Like valleys that stretch out, like gardens by the riverside, like aloes planted by YHVH, like cedars beside the waters."

(See the kingdom?)

Numbers (Numeros) 23:21

"He has not observed iniquity in Jacob, nor has He seen wickedness in Israel. **YHVH his Elohim [is] with him, and the shout of a King [is] among them."**

Numbers (Numeros) 23:9-10

“For **from the top of the rocks I see him**, and from the hills I behold him; There! A people dwelling alone, not reckoning itself among the nations.

Who can count the dust of Jacob, or number one-fourth of Israel? **Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my end be like his!”**
(Begin to see Kingdom? Enter Kingdom?)

Numbers (Numeros) 24:12-13

So Balaam said to Balak, "Did I not also speak to your messengers whom you sent to me, saying, 'If Balak were to give me his house full of silver and gold, I could not go beyond the word of YHVH, to do good or bad of my own will. What YHVH says, that I must speak'?"

Numbers (Numeros) 24:14

“And now, indeed, I am going to my people. Come, I will advise you what this people will do to your people in the latter days.”

Numbers (Numeros) 31:8

They killed the kings of Midian with [the rest of] those who were killed--Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, and Reba, the five kings of Midian. **Balaam the son of Beor they also killed with the sword.**

(Why not enter the kingdom?)

Numbers (Numeros) 22:31-32

Then YHVH opened Balaam's eyes, and he saw the Angel of YHVH standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand; and he bowed his head and fell flat on his face.

And the Angel of YHVH said to him, "Why have you struck your donkey these three times? Behold, I have come out to stand against you, because [your] way is perverse before Me."

Numbers (Numeros) 22:35

Then the Angel of YHVH said to Balaam, "Go with the men, but only the word that I speak to you, that you shall speak." So Balaam went with the princes of Balak.
(Messiah say?)

Matthew (Mateo) 13:22

Numbers (Numeros) 31:16

"Look, these [women] caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to trespass against YHVH in the incident of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of YHVH."

Numbers (Numeros) 23:8

"How shall I curse whom Elohim has not
cursed? And how shall I denounce [whom]
YHVH has not denounced?"

Numbers (Numeros) 23:21

"He has not observed iniquity in Jacob, nor has He seen wickedness in Israel. **YHVH his Elohim [is] with him, and the shout of a King [is] among them."**
