John (Juan) 3:1-2

There was a man of the Pharisees named
Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews.

This man came to Yeshua by night and said to
him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher
come from Elohim; for no one can do these
signs that you do unless Elohim is with him."

John (Juan) 3:3

Yeshua answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of Elohim."

John (Juan) 3:6-7

"That which is born of the flesh is flesh, **and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.**

Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'"

Jeremiah (Jeremias) 31:31, 34

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:8-9

For He said, "Surely they [are] My people, children [who] will not lie." **So He became their Savior.**

In all their affliction He was afflicted, **and the Angel of His Presence saved them**; in His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bore them and carried them all the days of old."

Exodus (Exodo) 5:2

And Pharaoh said, "Who [is] YHVH, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know YHVH, nor will I let Israel go."

(Could not see.)

Exodus (Exodo) 7:5

“And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] YHVH,
when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring
out the children of Israel from among them.”

Exodus (Exodo) 7:17

Thus says YHVH: **"By this you shall know that I [am] YHVH.** Behold, I will strike the waters which [are] in the river with the rod that [is] in my hand, and they shall be turned to blood."
(Who is speaking? Who is I?)

Exodus (Exodo) 8:10

So he said, "Tomorrow." And he said, "[Let it be] according to your word, **that you may know that [there is] no one like YHVH our Elohim.**"
(Frogs)

Exodus (Exodo) 8:22

"And in that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, in which My people dwell, that no swarms [of flies] shall be there, **in order that you may know that I [am] YHVH in the midst of the land.**"

Genesis 1:3-4

Then Elohim said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

And Elohim saw the light, **that [it was] good;** and Elohim divided the light from the darkness.

Exodus (Exodo) 9:14

“For at this time I will send all My plagues to your very heart, and on your servants and on your people, that you may know that [there is] none like Me in all the earth.”

Exodus (Exodo) 9:29

So Moses said to him, "As soon as I have gone out of the city, I will spread out my hands to YHVH; the thunder will cease, and there will be no more hail, **that you may know that the earth [is] YHVH's."**

Exodus (Exodo) 10:2

“And that you may tell in the hearing of your son and your son's son the mighty things I have done in Egypt, and My signs which I have done among them, that you may know that I [am] YHVH.”

Exodus (Exodo) 11:7

“But against none of the children of Israel shall a dog move its tongue, against man or beast, that you may know that YHVH does make a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.”

Exodus (Exodo) 14:18

“Then the Egyptians shall know that I [am] YHVH, when I have gained honor for Myself over Pharaoh, his chariots, and his horsemen.”

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:10-11

But **they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit**; so

He turned Himself against them as an enemy,

[And] He fought against them.

Then he remembered the days of old, Moses

[and] his people, [saying]: "Where [is] He who

brought them up out of the sea with the

shepherd of His flock? **Where [is] He who**

put His Holy Spirit within them,"

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:12-13

“**Who led [them]** by the right hand of Moses,
With His glorious arm, dividing the water before
them to make for Himself an everlasting name,
Who led them through the deep, as a horse in
the wilderness, that they might not stumble?”

Deuteronomy (Deuteronoio) 8:2

"And you shall remember that **YHVH your Elohim led you** all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you [and] test you, to know what [was] in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not."
(Like Spirit leading Messiah in desert to be tested)

Deuteronomy (Deuteronoio) 8:3

"So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger,
and fed you with manna which you did not
know nor did your fathers know, that He might
make you know that man shall not live by bread
alone; but man lives by every [word] that
proceeds from the mouth of YHVH."

(Messiah's first test)

Exodus (Exodo) 16:6-7

Then Moses and Aaron said to all the children of Israel, "At evening you shall know that YHVH has brought you out of the land of Egypt.

And in the morning you shall see the glory of YHVH; for He hears your complaints against YHVH. But what [are] we, that you complain against us?"

Exodus (Exodo) 18:10-11

And Jethro said, "Blessed [be] YHVH, who has delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians and out of the hand of Pharaoh, [and] who has delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians. Now I know that YHVH [is] greater than all the elohim; for in the very thing in which they behaved proudly, [He was] above them." (All earth see His Salvation Is.52:10)

Exodus (Exodo) 29:42-43

"This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations [at] the door of the tabernacle of meeting before YHVH, where I will meet you to speak with you. And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and [the tabernacle] shall be sanctified by My glory."

Exodus (Exodo) 29:45-46

"I will dwell among the children of Israel and will be their Elohim.

And they shall know that I [am] YHVH their Elohim, who brought them up out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them. I [am] YHVH their Elohim."

Exodus (Exodo) 31:13

"Speak also to the children of Israel, saying:
'Surely My Sabbaths you shall keep, for it [is] a
sign between Me and you throughout your
generations, that [you] may know that I
[am] YHVH who sanctifies you.'"

Isaiah (Isaias) 63:14

As a beast goes down into the valley, and **the Spirit of YHVH causes him to rest**, so You lead Your people, to make Yourself a glorious name.

(When Yah was done with His work-Making all things GOOD- He rested)

Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your sins; for My name [is] in Him. But if you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.
